## 52 miscreants held in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Dec 20: Three hijackers were among 52 miscreants arrested by Chittagong Metropolitan Police from different areas of the city during the past 24 hours ending six pm today, reports BSS.

Chittagong Police arrested Selim, 20, Faruk, 20, and Hefazul Islam Talukdar, 20, while they were extorting Taka 6000 and some articles at gun point from a rickshaw passenger returning from a city market at Char Rangarnatiya. Police recovered Tk 2500 out of Tk 6000.

## 'Advanced tech playing important role in dev'

Speaker Humayun Rasheed Chowdhury yesterday said that advanced communications had become an essential part of development as the foreign investors now assess the communications network of a given country as one of the essential factors for deciding their capital movement, reports BSS.

He said this while speaking as the chief guest at a presentation ceremony on 'Basic Information Structures for Government and Supporting Tech-

nologies' held in the Conference room of the Bangladesh Institute of Parliamentary Studies (IIPS).

Thorbjorn Christansen, an IT specialist of Norway, presented the keynote paper while Minister for Science and Technology Lt. Gen. (Retd) Noor Uddin Khan addressed the ceremony as special guest. Members of parliament, secretaries to the government and IT specialists were, among others, present in the function.

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## USTC library inaugural postponed

The inaugural ceremony of the central library and auditorium of the University of Science and Technology (USTC) scheduled for December 23, has been postponed, reports BSS.

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Ministers and leaders of the Awami League at a rally yesterday urged the Chief Justice to constitute a new bench during the ongoing vacation to review the split verdict in the Bangabandhu Murder Case by a High Court division bench, reports BSS.

They appealed to the Chief Justice to constitute a third bench immediately.

One judge of the High Court division bench in his verdict upheld the judgement of the trial court by confirming death

sentences to all the 15 convicts while the other judge acquitted five others.

The speakers said the verdict that upheld the death sentences should be executed immediately for the sake of democracy and for establishing the rule of law in the country.

Mohila Awami League organised the rally on the Central Shaheed Minar premises demanding immediate execution of the verdict in the Bangabandhu murder case.

Presided over by its President Begum Ily Rahman, the rally was addressed by Forest

and Environment Minister Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury, Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak, State Minister for Foreign Affairs Abul Hasan Chowdhury, State Minister for Shipping Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya, Bir Bikram, Haji Mohammad Makbul, MP, Abdul Mannan, Prof Abdul Mannan Chowdhury and Chhatra League president Bahadur Bepari and general secretary Ajoy Kar Khokon.

Begum Sajeda Chowdhury said that the Chief Justice should constitute a third bench in the High Court immediately during the vacation to review the split verdict as it is a national demand.

If a *razakar* (collaborator) can get bail from the court at midnight, why not the court should remain open during the vacation to hear the verdict in the Bangabandhu murder case," she added.

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak said the people of the country want immediate execution of the death sentences of the self-confessed killers of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

## Liberation War victims

## Nirmul Committee demands compensation from Pakistan

Ekatturer Ghatak Dalal Nirmul Committee yesterday demanded US \$30 billion from Pakistan as compensation for the victims of 1971 Liberation War, reports UNB.

The committee also urged the Bangladeshi government to take strong initiatives to realise the compensation from Pakistan for the victims and oppressed families.

The demand came in a discussion meeting at the Begum Sajeda Kamal auditorium at National Museum yesterday afternoon. Chaired by president of the advisory council of the Nirmul Committee Prof Kabir Chowdhury, the meeting was attended by Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak, Justice KM Sobhan, Major General (retired) KM Shafullah MP, Kazi Mukul, Barrister Tania Amir and leaders of different protestational bodies.

In a statement to the press Alisan Ali termed the reports carried by some dailies yesterday "confusing and incorrect."

He alleged a gang of 8-10 identified terrors led by one Lokman attacked him while on duty in the office at 12:45 pm and beat him severely abusing him as litigious.

Alisan rebutted the allegations against him of misusing power, harassing businessmen and service-holders and demanding bribes from them. "Certain vested interest group might have done this conspiratorially."

The district anti-corruption officer also denied that he fired blank shots from his own pistol.

"Rather the armed attackers who stormed into my room and threatened me opened fire while leaving the spot," he alleged.

During the discussion, free

"Come, touch my hand. I'll do everything I can do for you." Priyobhashinee, herself a victim of the repression in the Liberation War, urged the repressed women of the country to speak out.

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak demanded of Pakistan to return Tk 12.5 thousand crore. "Otherwise, what is our interest in keeping relations with this country?" he said.

He blamed the Pakistan government for delaying the departure of Irfan Raja from Bangladesh and said the Bangladeshi government took the right decision at the right time.

Prof Kabir Chowdhury said the government must seriously consider demanding compensation from Pakistan, putting aside the diplomatic niceties.
