Charges against '71 war criminals soon

WCFFC begins documentation of eyewitnesses' accounts

The War Crimes Fact Finding Committee (WCFFC) yesterday announced that it would frame charges soon against the Pakistani army personnel who committed the gruesome war crimes during the country's Liberation War in 1971.

WCFFC is compiling data and accounts of crimes against humanity committed by Pak forces during the Liberation War through documentation of eyewitnesses' accounts. This

compilation of data will be used to frame charges against the barbaric Pak forces.

The committee will conduct a public trial against the Pak Occupation forces and their local collaborators, WCFFC convenor Dr. Hasan said.

It cited the Paris Trial on Vietnam War and the Nuremberg Trial on genocide as other international trials of war criminals that have been car-

ried out elsewhere.

Others who were also present at the conference included Liberation War Museum Director Akku Chowdhury, Father R W Timm, Brother Donald of Saint Joseph School and College and Advocate Hedayetul Panna.

Five witnesses present at the event were Md. Akteruzzaman, an FDC employee, Alleva, a sweeper, Salema Be-

gun, mother of a martyr, Mari, a sweeper and Nurjahan Begum, a freedom fighter and rape victim.

The first three described the killing of children at Tejgaon Orphanage in December 1971. They recollected how 20 to 25 children were brutally killed in the second week of the month and buried in a mass grave.

Sweeper Mari described how the Pak forces captured him while he was trying to escape

through Darshana border. Along with the others captured, he was forced to bury over three thousand bodies of Bangladeshis in six months.

Freedom fighter and rape victim Nurjahan Begum narrated her own tragedy.

The speakers also urged all witnesses and victims to contact the members of the committee with authentic statement and eye-witness account.

Chinese, Thai envoys visit Khagrachhari
