Dhaka appeals for extradition of killers of Bangabandhu

Bangladesh has made a fervent appeal to the governments favouring democracy and upholding human rights throughout the world to help apprehend the killers of the country's founding father Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in line with UN resolutions, reports BSS.

The appeal was made by Foreign Secretary C M Shafi Sami in an article headlined "An appeal to the world: Help apprehend these murderers" published in the International Herald Tribune on the Victory Day on December 16.

The Foreign Secretary said that the human rights aspects of this issue came up this year in the General Assembly of the UN Commission on Human Rights. He said that "a resolution of the General Assembly strongly opposed in granting of refuge to assassins".

Those convicted in the murder of Bangabandhu should not be allowed to "evade justice and be given refuge in any country that is committed to democracy, fundamental human rights and rule of law," Shafi Sami said.

Referring to the killers, the

foreign secretary said they have been convicted after a "free, fair and open trial" and that the victims of the murder on the "darkest and saddest day in the history of Bangladesh" were the "head of state and founding father of Bangladesh and members of his family."

The foreign secretary said that though "these killers have committed the worst possible violation of human rights... it is baffling that importance is placed on the perceived threat to the human rights of these criminals, ignoring the actual act of violation of human rights committed by them against innocent people."

Shafi Sami opined that absence of extradition treaty cannot stand on the way of bringing back or sending criminals from one country to another and cited several examples of handing over of wanted persons from one country to other without treaty.

"The absence of an extradition treaty has not stood in the way of returning criminals to

the country where their offences were committed," he said, adding that Major (ret'd) Bazul Huda, one of the convicted killers, was brought back from Bangkok even though Bangladesh and Thailand had no extradition treaty at that time.

The foreign secretary mentioned that of the 15 persons who were convicted in the trial for the killing of Bangabandhu, only four are now in custody. Eleven are still at large having taken refuge in different countries. This was not a political crime it was perpetrated against women, pregnant newlyweds and innocent children, he said, adding that "there is a strong political implication".

Bangladesh's efforts to bring these violators of human rights to justice "deserve the support and cooperation of the international community," Shafi Sami said in his appeal. He said in this enlightened age, no country should become a "safe haven to criminals and terrorists".

51 miscreants held in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Dec 23: Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) arrested 51 miscreants including an extortionist, on various charges from different areas of the city during the last 24 hours ending six pm today, reports BSS.

Double Mooring police arrested one Mohammad Masud, 25, while extorting toils in Madarbari area.

Bakolia police arrested one Abdul Gani and Jahangir Hossain from Kala Mea Bazar and recovered two kgs of ganja from them.

Other police stations under CMP rounded up 48 miscreants from different areas of city.

Trader robbed of Tk 17 lakh

SYLHET, Dec 23: Muggers snatched Tk 17 lakh from a trader near Jababhat residential area in the town on Thursday, reports UNB.

Sources said four muggers riding in two motorcycles swooped on the trader at about 8 pm when he was returning home by a rickshaw.

However, the trader did not file any case with the police as he was allegedly engaged in illegal hundi business.

Meanwhile, police seized about 200 motorcycles in a drive during last three days since Wednesday as muggers are now using motorcycles to rob the passers-by.

Edn Minister to hold talks with BFTA

Education Minister ASHK Sadeque has agreed to sit in formal meeting with Bangladesh Federation of Teachers' Association (BFTA) to thrash out complications in regard to inclusion of non-government teachers in the Monthly Pay Order (MPO) and appointment of non-government teachers through the Public Service Commission (PSC).

The press release signed by BFTA General Secretary Principal Quazi Faruque Ahmed, said that the other agenda of the meeting are execution of the government decision to pay 10 per cent enhanced pay with effect from July 2000, payment of the medical allowance and increment in the new national pay scale and promotion of college and school teachers.

The federation leaders have expressed optimism that the outcome of the meeting will be positive, the release added.

Meanwhile, BFTA has requested non-government teachers, particularly those holding third division in any board exams, appointed before August 24, to send information sheets stating their academic qualifications from SSC to Masters before January 10, 2001 to the central BFTA office at 62 Nazimuddin Road.

Change in EASY Pre-Paid recharge procedure

Some changes have been incorporated in the EASY recharging procedure for improving GrameenPhone EASY Pre-Paid Service. To notify the changed procedure to EASY Pre-Paid subscribers the recharge procedure is mentioned below :

- Step 01 : Scratch off the gray area of your EASY card carefully to reveal your unique hidden number.
- Step 02 : To use your mobile, call 555 from your mobile to connect with the EASY recharging service.
- Step 03 : After you are connected, wait to be instructed to enter the hidden number printed on your EASY card.
- Step 04 : After you are instructed, enter your hidden number by dialing the number on your mobile handset keypad and press hash (#). At this point wait for a few seconds.
- Step 05 : The hidden number that you have entered will be automatically played to you. If you are sure that the played hidden number is correct then press "2" to confirm. If the played hidden number is not correct, press "1" at this stage to re-enter the correct hidden number.
- If you have failed three (3) times to enter the correct hidden number, your account will be temporarily blocked. To unblock your account, you will have to contact Customer Relations Department.
- Step 06 : Once your hidden number is accepted and your account is recharged, you will hear a voice notification confirming your new account balance, expiration date of your EASY card and the last date till which you can recharge your account.
- Step 07 : Now you can start using your mobile phone.
