
Chobi Mela's 'Nepal by Nepalis' photo show ends at the Shilparag, Dhanmondi

A captivating land that draws tourists from across the world is Nepal, laying at the foot of the Himalayas. Kathmandu has been one of the major tourist spots in the world. As such tourism industry has blossomed in this small country of South Asia. But like any other country of the region it also encounters political and socio-religious crisis that make up its national history. This country boasts of its rich cultural heritage and tradition. To make an exposure of the nation, Nepali photographers have taken a part in the ongoing Chobi Mela, the biggest photographic extravaganza in Asia hosted by Dhaka.

Images tell how bounteous the nature is in Nepal. But there is also the flip side of the coin. Though the visitors call Nepal the queen of the nature, political turmoil often hit the country with all its ferocity and ugliness. Besides, various measures taken by the establishment are often tantamount to the violation of people's civic and human rights. Right at the entrance of the gallery one image titled 'water-life' of some lively women seeking their livelihood in a brook, would draw one's casual attention. But a sad tale underlies beneath this usual activities of life. A group of a minority nationality called Tharu women are seen catching fish in the Karnali river of west Nepal. The government of Nepal is counting the giant energy com-

the world. Alongside multifarious evils, nature's elegance and serenity produce a beautiful contrast and a blissful posture in Nepal. Mt. Kushang Kang is one of countless instances that add to the immensity of Nepal's unearthly beauty. A picture called 'Mt. Kushang Kang and Moon' in the Everest region captures a unique moment in which a pretty bird is seen about to take off on the crest of the mountain covered with milk-white ice against the backdrop of a glowing full moon making the mountain's crest beam with a heavenly aura. In 'Together' two birds appear on the Chanpudevi Danda (hill) of Kathmandu. The Kathmandu Valley is known for the great variety of birds that make it their home and that migrate through it. But of



late pollution is threatening their habitat along that of the people who live in the valley. An image of growing corn sheaves titled 'Fertility' snapped from the city of Kathmandu gives an idea of Nepal's soil productivity. Farmers of the middle hills region of Nepal are fortunate enough to have fertile land and sufficient water for plantation. Photographs on the activities of Nepal communist party (Maolist) hint at the country's political unrest. To get to the true picture, an image called 'Family' shows a family out for a stroll on the still streets of Kathmandu during a Bandh (strike) called by the Nepal Communist Party which has been waging a 'people's war' in the country for five years now. 'Cruelty' is another picture which exhibits police repression on a

protest programme against the Indian Army occupation of Nepali territory, staged by nine leftist parties in front of the Indian Embassy in Kathmandu in 1988. Since the Indo-Chinese war of the early 1960s the Indian Army has occupied a large area of land in the Kalapani region of far western Nepal. Although maps and other historical evidence show this is Nepali territory, the Indian government still refuses to formally acknowledge this or to remove its troops. In 'Turbulent peace' police are seen arresting a worker of the All India Women's Association (Revolutionary) that affiliated with the NCP. 'The Moments of Marriage' and 'Wedding Orchestra' project a glimpse of Nepali cultural rites. In The Moments of Marriage a traditional wedding procession is seen in a village on the national highway leading to Kathmandu. The bride is carried in a traditional 'Tandon' to her in-laws' home surrounded by her husband's friends and relatives who have fetched her from the natal home she must now give up or give her up. In Nepal daughters have no rights in parental property unless they remain unmarried after the age of 35. 'Wedding orchestra' depicts the traditional wedding musicians called 'Daris', a caste considered as untouchables by those who utilize their services. This photography show will help the viewers to form an intimate idea of Nepal and leave a lasting impression upon them.

### Pleasure of Life

Pleasure of Life is a group exhibition, a part of Chobi Mela, the 1st Festival of Photography in Asia, which started on December 19 at the Indian Cultural Centre. This exhibition is the final product of World Press Photo's series of three seminars held annually at Pathshala since 1998. Along with Bangladeshi photographers, there were groups from Bosnia Herzegovina, Peru and Zimbabwe. Through the intensive process of analysis and editing, argument and review, what finally stands is a complex and distinctive collection of photo stories, images and words that expresses each individual photographer's search into the theme 'Pleasure of Life'. The exhibition will remain open from 10:00a.m - 6:00p.m. everyday till January 3, 2001.

Another exhibition of Chobi Mela, by Great Britain's photographer John Kippin is going on at the gallery Chitrak. The exhibition started on December 17 and is 'concerned with representing the cultural construct that we call the landscape'. The exhibition will remain open to all from 10:00a.m - 8:00p.m. till December 31.

## Speaking Thru' a Camera

Nepali photographer Usha Tiwari catches fleeting moments in her frames in her exhibition at Shilparag

MOMENT of Marriage, Wedding Orchestra, Loving Look, Street Play, Colourful Journey and a host of other photographs by Usha Tiwari from Nepal are on show at the Shilparag Gallery in the city this week. The exhibition is part of the ongoing 1st Festival of Photography in Asia or Chobi Mela and Usha's very interesting images have found their way among other participants from Nepal.

It's hard to imagine that this lively, bubbly and spirited 28-year-old young woman sees life in so many serious angles around her. Usha, who has made camera a part of her existence since she was 15, is a freelancer now, and a very politically conscious young lady, who wants to present the plight of the common people with the lens. A fastidious eye for details is her forte. Social disparity in everyday life, the plight of women, traditionalism versus progressive forces in the society all find a place in this young lady's works.

Usha while describing her passion for this field of work, draws an analogy with a writer who has a pen as a weapon to

present his feelings and beliefs, a photographer has his camera to capture all that he or she wants to express. Usha finds the ability of a camera to express intimate description of life fascinating and convinced that photography is a very powerful medium and if used correctly, able to get through message to millions that hundreds of words or speeches could not possibly do. She further defines her work explaining how it differs from the writers' pen. The field of photography is a little bit more difficult since a writer can write and rewrite to make his composition better but a photographer has to have the adaptability and presence of mind to instantaneously capture what is happening or occurring around him/her.

Some of the pieces of Usha's composition stand witness to her passion for human kind and social causes. In Turbulent Peace and in Exhibition Against Exhibitionism, taken from different political protests ongoing in her country at the moment, in Street Play the plights of the streeturchins (called khate in Nepal as we have our tokais here) come to life with a passion.

One very interesting composition titled Helping Hands which shows a family at a leisurely

moment, the mother and daughter sitting relaxed while the father oils the newborn in the family. In the background even the housemaid is at leisure, sitting and watching the family at a homely moment. This is a reversal of roles, Usha explains, since the mother is generally expected in the family to tend to this kind of work in the society. Instead this is a movement of the socially progressive people in her country who are gradually breaking out from this kind of social practices to pave the way for a better partnership in life.

Usha feels very strongly about what is ongoing around her and she likes to ensure that the message she is trying to put across is communicated to the people who will be seeing her work. For this reason her captions are long explaining the background of each photograph taken in order to enable the viewers see beyond what comes as the first perception of a picture.

Usha is herself a picture of progress in her country. She is the first woman photographer in her country. The All Nepal Women's Association in this context honoured her. At present working as a freelancer gives her the freedom to pursue her



subjects and her works have already been published in famous magazines all around the region including Spotlight, Lok Uddha, Outlook (India), Surya, Sainik Awaz, Richa, Asmita, Vikas, Himal S.A., Samlalin Tisri Dunya and Liberation (India). She feels that through her lens she has been able to capture pictures of people's movements of her time. She hopes to have enough pictures to set up a museum in the next 15 years' time which will tell the history of these times still frames.

In her personal life, Usha feels very lucky to come from a family which supports her in a society as conservative as hers, and that she is able to pursue her passion.



exhibition titled 'Nepal by Nepalis' had showcased works of the Nepali photographers from December 17 to 23 focusing the country's day to day life in simplicity in the lap of nature, socio-economic life of its population, their political life and above all cultural and traditional phenomena.

Nepali photographers featured in the show including Usha Tiwari, at Shilparag Gallery, are Ravi Manandhar, Narendra Shrestha, Min Bajracharya Jagadish Tiwari, a professional photographer and expert on mountain photography and Bikash Ramnar a professional photographer.

A number of photographs on the show is an honest testimony to the country's richness in marvelous natural beauty. These
