
The Return of The Native

Bangladeshi-Greek artist Omar Zafar's interactive paintings captivate city's gallery-goers

N Athens-based young artist Omar Zafar has Lunveiled a new horizon of painting by hammering a way which invites art lovers and admirers along with artists into an interactive creation of art. 




