## Hasina inaugurates Rangamati digital phone exchange

**This kind of development projects possible only because of CHT accord, she says**

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday inaugurated a 300-line Rangamati digital telephone exchange saying that the modern telecommunications facility in the remote area is an outcome of the Chittagong Hill Tracts peace accord, reports UNB.

"It was unimaginable to undertake such a development project in CHT before the signing of the peace accord on December 2, 1997, that ended over two decades of insurgencies in the hills," she said while opening the exchange by making the maiden phone call from her office to Post and Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nassim who was at the Rangamati end.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, who also talked to the Minister for Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Kalpa Rajan Chakma, members of parliament Bir Bahadur and Dipankar Talukdar, said her government concentrated on infrastructure and socio-economic development of the region now that peace is prevailing there.

She thanked the officials and employees of the Post and Telecommunications Ministry and the T&T Board for their untiring effort in bringing massive development in the telecommunications sector.

Rangamati became the 34<sup>th</sup> district to be covered by the modern digital telephone network and some 790 existing analogue telephones under the exchange will be digitalised. It also has the capacity of providing 2,210 new connections.

The project, being implemented with financial assistance from the Chinese government, is part of the programme for installation of 2.16 lakh digital phones in the district headquarters of Bangladesh.

AL programmes on Bangabandhu's Homecoming Day

Bangladesh Awami League has taken up an elaborate programme to observe the homecoming day of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman on Jan 10, reports UNB.

The programmes include hoisting of national and party flags at Bangabandhu Bhaban, the party central office and its offices across the country at 6 am.
