Computer security to cost \$3b over three years

SINGAPORE. Jan 9: Computer users will spend more than \$3 billion over the next three years on security software to combat a rise in computerrelated offenses such as hacking, a computer analysis company said Tuesday, reports AP,

A report by International Data Corporation said the market for security software was set to reach \$3.397 billion in 2004. up from \$266 million in 1999. as enterprises rush to protect themselves from a rise in corporate espionage and computer hacking.

It said security breaches such as vandalised Web sites. computer viruses. information theft and denial of service at electronic commerce and support sites were the main problems for corporations.

Last year, computer viruses Melissa and the Lovebug swept the computer world and closed down infected computers.
