**Effective flood warning can help save life, property**

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak yesterday stressed on effective dissemination of flood forecast and warning messages at grassroots level to reduce damage to livestock, infrastructure, buildings, injury, death and disruption of economic activity.

In his speech as chief guest at the 2<sup>nd</sup> National Workshop on "Improved Flood Warning Dissemination" held in a city hotel, he also said, "as soon as the warning information is disseminated, the poor community will be aware of the impending disaster and be able to protect their respective livestock and properties."

Under to the existing system, we could be informed of the disaster 48 hours in advance but we need to use a satellite to monitor the flood and forecast to get information at the right time so that people in the flood prone areas can be evacuated to safer places like, schools, colleges, madrassahs and cyclone shelter centres", he added.

He also said that the government will adopt suggestions found in such workshops for the greater welfare of countrymen.

Organised by Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre (FFWC), a project of Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) in association with DHI Water and Environment, the workshop was sponsored by DANIDA.

The minister thanked the Danish government and DANIDA for their co-operation in the project.

Presiding over the concluding session of the programme, Azad Ruhul Amin, secretary of Ministry of Water Resources said, "though we cannot stop floods, we can reduce the loss and casualties through precaution and warning messages."

He added, "due to failure of structural measures like em-

bankments and dams in protecting flood, non-structural measure has got more importance."

"All concerned organisations have to work together with the local peoples, specially mosque's imams, teachers and doctors, for effective dissemination of the warning messages", the secretary pointed out.

Participants also discussed on baseline surveys conducted in three pilot areas - Louhajang (thana in Munshiganj), Chouhali in Sirajganj and Sundarganj in Gaibandha district. They recommended some preparatory measures, including regular drainage of the canals, boulder placement with netting along the river banks in vulnerable area, more flood shelters and raised land or killa for safety of livestock, regular information on rise and fall of water in the rivers and door-to-door announcement by trained volunteers corps.

They also recommended use of modern media including internet, cellular phones, fax in dissemination of such information.

The programme was also addressed, among others, by director general of BWDB AKM Halimur Rahman, FFEC project director ANH Akhter Hossain and executive engineer of FFWC Selim Bhuyian.

The five-year project (2000-2004) consists of two major components - flood forecasting by FFWC and warning dissemination. DANIDA is funding the project - Consolidation and Strengthening of Flood Forecasting and Warning Services. BWDB and Danish Hydraulic Institution (DHI) in association with SWMC, MML, NCG, AQUA and partner NGOs implement the project. An inter-ministerial steering committee represented by concerned agencies provides overall policy guidelines for the project.

**Mongla Port handled 30 lakh tonnes of cargo**

KHULNA, Jan 11: Mongla Port handled a total of 30 lakh 35 thousand tonnes of cargo during the last six months (from July 2000 to December 2000), reports BSS.

Of the total, 11 lakh 60 thousand tonnes were import cargo and about 1 lakh 74 thousand 272 metric tonnes were export cargo.

The import cargo included foodgrains, cement clinkers, coal, machinery and general cargo. The export cargo included jute, jute goods, shrimps, white fish, tea and general cargo.

During the period, a total of 1 hundred and 47 ships called at the port 1 hundred 45 ship sailed off the port.

**Cardiologist team of Germany to treat from Jan 26**

A team of German cardiologists will provide treatment in cooperation with the Cardiology Department of the Combined Military Hospital (CMH) for three weeks from January 26, reports UNB.

During their stay the cardiologists, with the cardiac surgeons of Bangladesh, will take part in all types of open-heart surgery including CABG, beating heart surgery, valve transplantation and defects of heart from childhood.

They will render their service to the members of the Armed Forces as well as other people.

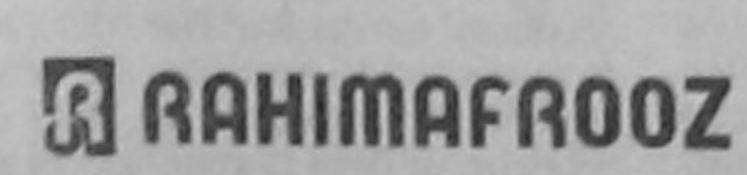
