Capturing Faces within Faces

Shishu Academy holds an exhibition of portrait photography which is the result of a workshop hosted by Drik.

ORTRAIT photography is still in its infancy in Bangladesh. Encounters with internationally famed photographers as well as getting international exposure are the keys to take our photography to international photographic mainstream: and Drik has exactly done that by organising the 1st Photography Festival in Asia or Chobi Mela, currently being held in Dhaka, which will open up a new forum for learning and sharing photographic experiences. This photography festival, it is expected, punctuated with various academic sessions will pave passages to newer dimensions of photographic art. As an outcome, country's photography will gain a

significant drive for its progression. As part of Chobi Mela, a workshop was held on portraits between Nov. 30 and Dec. 9, 2000 at Pathshala--South Asian Institute of Photography, resulting in an exhibition of portrait photographs titled 'Faces within Faces'. A total of 16 photographers, 14 Pathshala diploma and graduate students and 2 externals, took part in the workshop conducted by Thomas Luttge and Eric Huber-- photographers from Germany and Switzerland respectively.

We, due to subjectivity, often escape noticing an artistic value, meaning, beauty and coincidence of light and space when we experience person. In most cases human observation lacks objectivity. But a camera sees an object objectively. So we can learn by watching our photo-





graphs with more time to understand and observe what camera captures. A camera is not confused like we some times are. It is an effective device to help us for a better understudying of the world

The participants of the workshop used to start thier day early in the morning shooting. In the afternoon, they all met at the Pathshala. The participants would then sit with the days work and select some frames from contact sheets and then, with Thomas and Eric, to engage themselves in an evaluation of their work. After serious discussions work prints would be made from the chosen frames, and enlargements for the exhibition.

The photographs were taken under four themes, Space, Light, Moment and Faces. In the theme Space, a black and white picture taken by Golam Mostafa Akash depicts a woman washing utensils and other household materials in a pond. In the same section again, an angular turning space with a boy peeping out of curiosity, is a snap shot by Azizur Rahim Pue.

When spectators turn to the next section called Light, they would be amazed by the splendid sport of light and shade to make photographs appear aesthetically valuable. One image in black and white by

section, is a man's face where light and shade has been captured in such a way that it make it to give a different look. In another picture by Saeyad Farhana, a woman's face appears to be a canvas in which light portrays an image of itself giving birth to a mystery on the face. Shade divides the face keeping one part of it under darkness while light makes the other part visible. Next the visitors plunge into a captivating mystery created by light entering through a window grills and falling upon a woman singing with her musical instruments. plicity of black and white. In the section called Moment, some fleeting moments have been framed brilliantly. These moments are captured in black and white, as it were, to adhere to exactness and unmixed reality of the events. Moments of boys running in an open field, workers tying up bamboo frame for construction work, an elderly man chopping wood and piling them up and a sweating moment of arduous earth work constitute this section.

And the last section called Faces,

is a gallery of faces with various expressions. This portrait gallery presents expressions of pleasure, exclamation, worry, disgust, grief, despair, meditation, inquisitiveness and happy faces in light and shade.

The participants had to undergo different phases to get to the theme of portrait photography. Three stages of the process were social position, dreamy state of the mind and personality, unrepeatable moments of a person. social position of a person is determined by the factors--society, position, role and individual abilities. dreamy state of mind is a kind of absence as a possibility for an inner retreat.

The workshop Faces within Faces was meant to focus on the dialogue between the persons-- in front of the camera and behind the camera. The exhibition will remain open

till January 17 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
