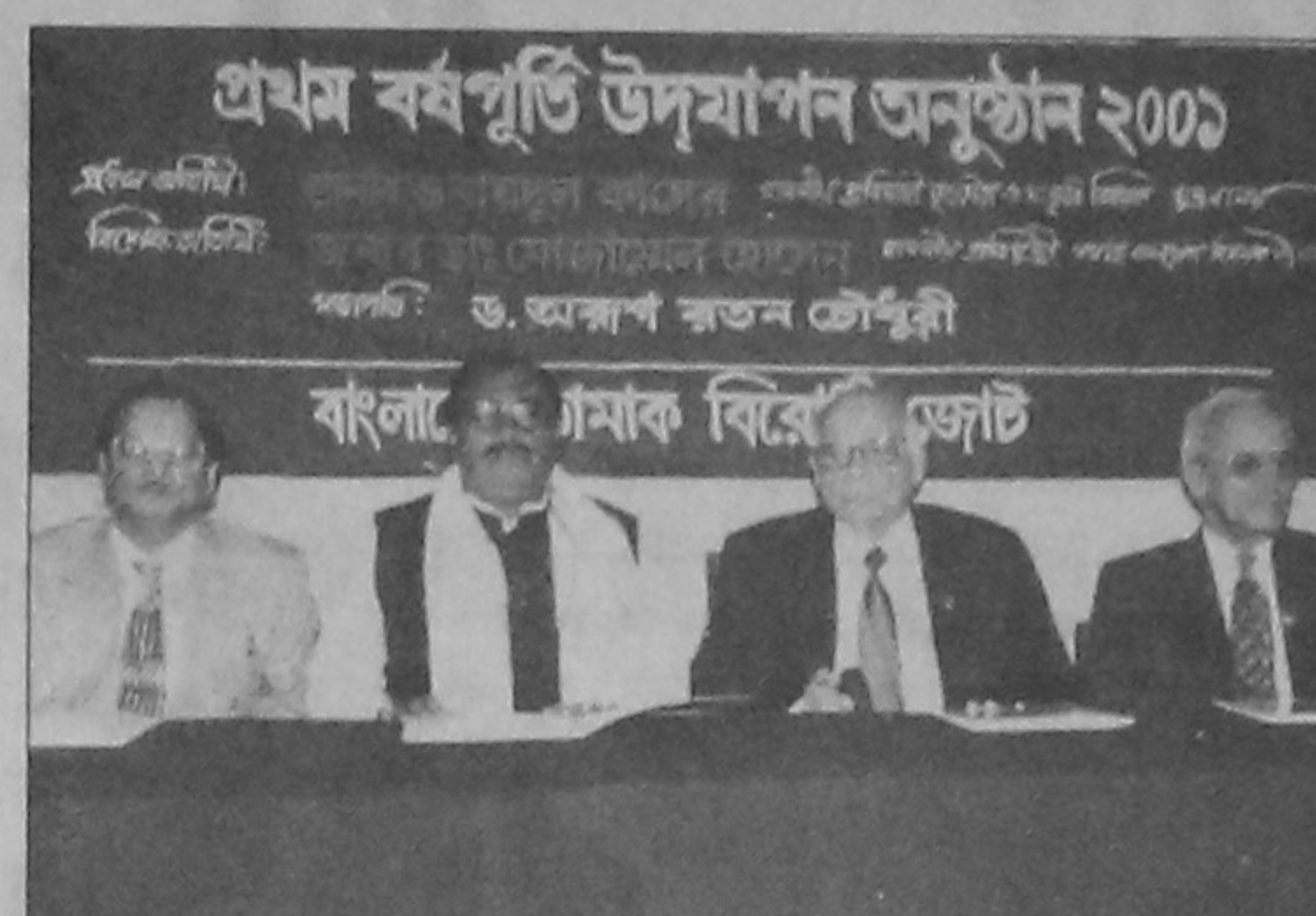

They blamed BNP for creating terrorism on the court premises and demanded trial of those involved in the incident.

Meanwhile, the BCL will hold an emergency meeting of its central executive committee at the party office tomorrow.

Police said, masterminds and key figures involved in the murder are yet to be arrested.

Meanwhile name of a Jubo League leader, who played key role in the murder, has not been included in the FIR. He is the man behind the murder of the UP chairman, said the IO of the case.

We have been asked by some AL leaders not to arrest Mohammad Alam, Secretary of Dumuria thana Jubo League. Alam is the prime suspect of the murder of Kabilul Islam, said IO of Dumuria thana.

Three pirates arrested while collecting ransom

KHULNA, Jan 13: Three alleged pirates were arrested by Sonadanga thana police on Friday night while collecting Taka 10,000 as ransom for releasing two Banvalis of the Sundarbans from Jubo League leader Faruque Ahmed.

Earlier they allegedly kidnapped the Banvalis and demanded the amount as ransom for releasing the Banvalis who work as employees of the Jubo League leader's Gopata business.

According to police, the alleged pirates came to Khulna from the Sundarbans to collect the ransom keeping the two Banvalis hostage.

The arrested pirates have been identified as Abdul Malek, 28, and Shahidul Islam, 30, of Bagerhat town.
