SAINT-ETIENNE. France, Jan 14: Paris Saint Germain president Laurent Perpere said Saturday the deal which would bring Brazilian international forward Ronaldinho "Gaucho" to the French side is close to completion, reports AFP.

"Nothing's signed yet. We're close to completing the transfer. I would really like to get it over and done with," Perpere told AFP prior to the Saint Etienne-PSG match.

Perpere added: "In any case, his (Ronaldinho) arrival during the transfer window seems a bit unlikely to me.

On Friday Parisian radio station Sport O'FM had announced that 20-year-old Ronaldinho had signed a five-year contract with the capital club.

Ronaldinho currently plays at Brazilian club Gremio and his arrival looks even more imminent following a Friday meeting between Gremio representatives and the player's agent, also his brother.


