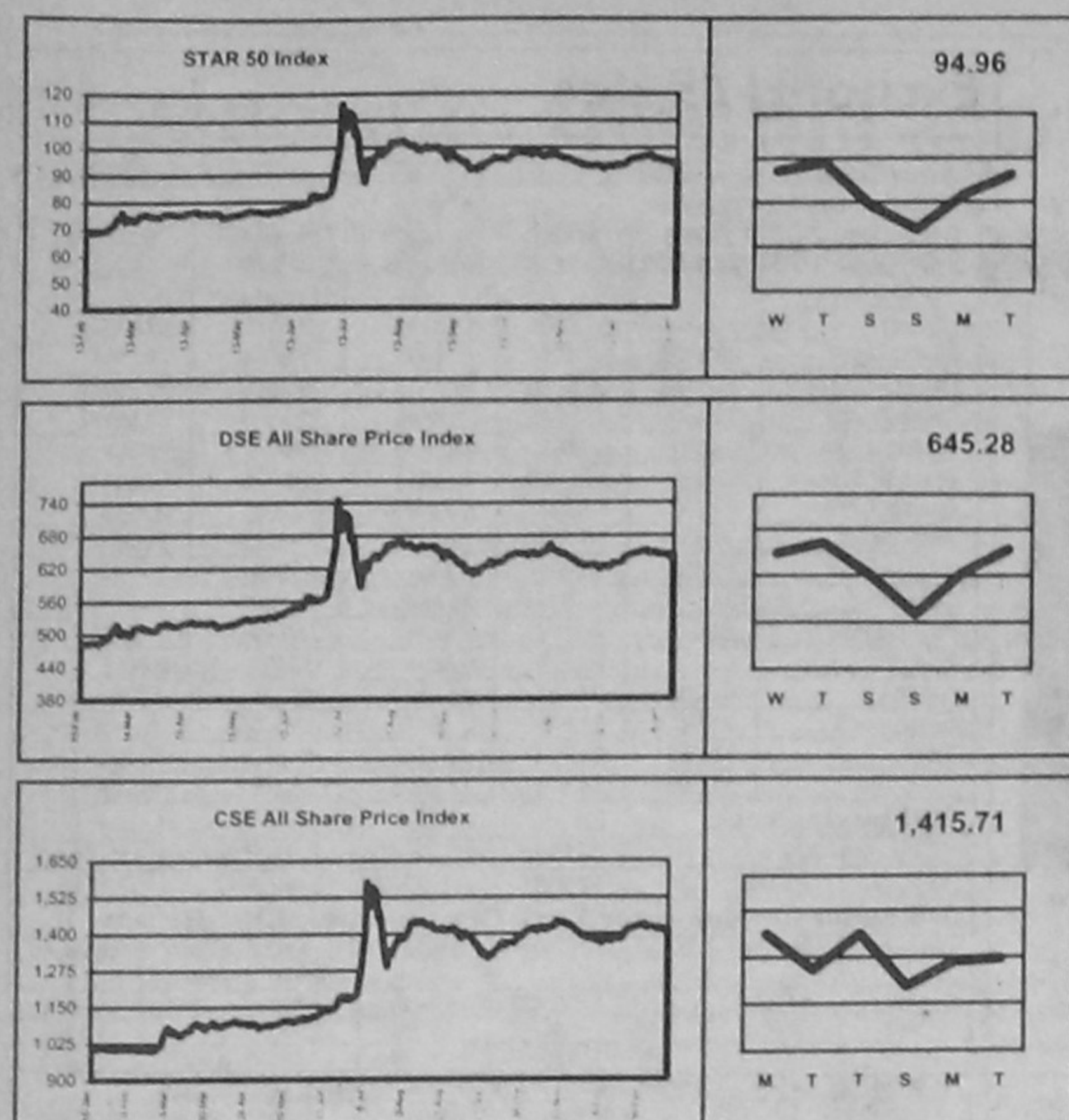

BFTA

Bangladesh Federation of Teachers' Association (BFTA) yesterday welcomed the new national education policy that has been placed before the parliament, and demanded its speedy implementation.

In a statement, the BFTA leaders, including its acting chairman Md. Azizul Islam and secretary general Prof. Quazi Faruque Ahmed and leaders and of the organisations belonging to the BFTA, urged the government to take appropriate steps to implement the education policy.

Their other demands include extension of tenure of reserved seats to 10 years, increase in number of the reserved seats to 64 from 30 and nomination for 10 per cent of the women candidates by different political parties during the election.

The SNS staged the programme from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm to pressurise both the ruling party and opposition in the winter session of parliament and to mobilise public opinion in support of their demands.

Some 75 persons from 19 women organisations and human rights organisations took
