Most of the 6,500 workers at Daewoo's main plant in Bupyong, 30 kilometers (18 miles) west of Seoul, walked off their jobs at noon, but returned to work in a couple of hours, Choi

"Layoffs as part of restructuring is a matter both sides should discuss, not an excuse to strike. We will sternly deal with it," said Lee Chang-won, a
