Law to protect sex workers demanded

The commercial sex workers (CSW) in the country have no security in the society, as there is no specific law for their protection. Speakers at a day-long open dialogue in the city yesterday said this and demanded that the government immediately enact specific laws for their protection. The speakers said that the CSWs are neither recognised in their profession or in the society. "This is in violation of human rights," said one of the speakers. Advocate Salma Ali, President of Bangladesh National Women Lawyers' Association (BNWLA) said that there is no specific law at present that can give full protection to the CSWs. On the other hand, the 1933 and 2000 the Women and Children Oppression Act is not being implemented properly, she said. Bangladesh Mental Health Association International organised the dialogue on 'Legal Assistance for CSWs, Present and Future: Bangladesh Perspective'. Dr Michel Radford, president of the association, presided over the event.

He arrived at the house with the young woman on January 14. The young man had told the landlord that the lady had been brought to the city from Rangpur for treatment. The landlord called the police yesterday morning after discovering a bad smell coming out of the house. Police sent the body to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy. A case has been filed with Sabujbagh police station in this regard.
