LITTLE ROCK, Arkansas, Jan 18: US President Bill Clinton on Wednesday made the last official visit of his tenure, to his home state Arkansas where he first entered politics more than 25 years ago, reports AFP.

Clinton, who in three days' time will hand over office to his successor, Republican Presidentelect George W. Bush, received a warm reception from both chambers of the state legislature.

He spoke for an hour on the progress his native Arkansas and the United States as a whole has made since his election to the White House eight years and two terms ago.

'I will leave office at noon on the 20th amazingly grateful that somehow the mystery of this great democracy gave me the chance to go from a little boy on South Hervey Street in Hope. Arkansas to the White House, Clinton said toward the end of his speech.

Davis said he had instructed the state's Department of Water Resources to buy power to keep the lights on in California for the next week to 10 days, while his administration tries to resolve the energy crisis.

MOSCOW, Jan 18: Pavel Borodin, former confidant of ex-Russian president Boris Yeltsin and powerful Kremlin property manager, has been arrested at New York's JFK airport, Moscow news reports said today, reports

Borodin was arrested late Wednesday under an international warrant issued by Swiss prosecutors last January in connection with money laundering charges, ITAR-TASS reported.

A closed-door court hearing was scheduled for 1630 GMT Thursday in Manhattan, the news agency said.

Tory boosted by donation

LONDON, Jan 18: The stakes in Britain's forthcoming election were raised today when the opposition Conservative Party said it had received a five-million-pound (7.3 million-dollar) donation, the biggest in British political history, reports AFP.

The massive gift, from a businessman, redresses the balance for the Conservatives after the ruling Labour Party bolstered its election war chest last month with three separate donations worth two million pounds each.

Lower House of Parliament voted overwhelmingly late Wednesday in favour of a controversial ban on fox-hunting, though the measure still has to be approved in the Upper Chamber, reports AFP.

Lawmakers in the House of Commons voted by 387 to 174 in lavour of a motion banning the blood sport, having already rejected a compromise option of letting fox-hunting continue under a licensing scheme.

The banning legislation is likely to face stiff resistance in the ipper chamber, the House of Lords, where pro-hunting conservatives hold a majority.


