# Hydrological study in neighbouring countries must for flood forecast

## Participants' observation at BUP seminar

Hydrological study of the embankments in the neighbouring countries is needed for correct flood forecast. The country was not at all prepared for the unusual flood at the south-west region of the country last year due to lack of such forecast.

Participants in the seminar on 'Floods 2000: South-Western Region of Bangladesh' also observed that the flood forecasting and warning system should be extended to the south-western part of the Bangladesh and the adjacent areas in West Bengal in India.

Organised by Bangladesh Umayyad Parishad (BUP) the programme was attended by the experts from Ministry of Water Resources, Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB), Joint River Commission (JRC), NGOs, Asian Development Bank and people of different professions.

While presenting his paper on 'Floods 2000: Causes and Consequences' Director of Surface Modeling Centre Emaduddin Ahmed said that although Bangladesh has high technical capability of flood forecasting, it is not properly disseminated to grass route level people.

The participants also identified unplanned roads, encroachment of the drainage routes, choking of channels, shrimp cultivation in the floodplains as well as absence of integrated land and water resources management as reasons behind the flood at the region last year.

Director of Processing and Flood Forecasting, BWDB A N H Akhter Hussain presented his paper on 'People oriented flood information dissemination'.

Referring to pilot studies conducted at six unions of three districts, he disclosed that hundred per cent respondents replied in the negative when asked about dissemination of flood warning by public authorities. He opined that a topographical survey of the country is immediately required for the flood forecasting purpose.

Chief Engineer (Hydrology) of BWDB A K M Shamsul Islam said that now we have to consider whether we should go for extending the flood forecasting system in such a region which did not experienced flood within more than last fifty years.

Emaduddin Ahmed, however, said "We should get prepared because we never know when flood will hit the same area next time."

## Hasina pays tributes to Shaheed Asad

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday paid rich tributes to Shaheed Asad and those who embraced martyrdom during the historic anti-Ayub movement which culminated in the War of Liberation resulting in the independence of Bangladesh, reports BSS.

The prime minister, speaking as the chief guest at the Sixth Convocation of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET), said today's event coincided with the Shaheed Asad Day. Student leader Amanullah Mohammad Asaduzzaman was gunned down while leading an anti-Ayub procession in 1969.

The death of Asad turned the movement into mass upsurge hastening the fall of Ayub regime. Later, the Bengalees' struggle for self-determination took the shape of the War of Liberation, she added.

Sheikh Hasina recalled the contribution of BUET students in the historic 6-point and 11-point movement and in '69 mass upsurge.

As a student of Dhaka University, I myself had also some role in these movements," Hasina told the gathering.
