Gen (ret'd) Munim passes away

General (ret'd) Mohammad Abdul Munim, a former minister, died of a cardiac arrest on his way to the Combined Military Hospital (CMH) at about 12:30 pm yesterday. He was 65.

Gen Munim left behind his wife Dr Ayesha Munim, a professor of Physics at Dhaka University, four daughters, a number of grandchildren and a host of relatives and friends to mourn his death.

Gen Munim was the chief of Electrical Mechanical Engineering (EME) Core of the Bangladesh Army.

The late general was made the Chairman of Power Development Board (PDB) during the tenure of President Ziaur Rahman. He also served as Minister for Public Works, Agriculture, Health and Finance during the Ershad regime.

His namaj-e-Janaza was held at the mosque at Dhanmondi Road-7 yesterday. His second Janaza will be held at Allah-hu-Mosque in the Cantonment after Zohr prayers on Tuesday and he will be buried at the Army graveyard.

His qukhani will be held on Wednesday after Magrib prayers at his residence at House-33, Road -7, Dhanmondi.

In a message of condolence, M Syeduzzaman, former finance minister, said country has lost a dedicated public servant of high integrity, an able administrator, a technocrat, a true professional soldier and a fine gentleman at his death.

Even after his retirement from public service, Munim was associated with various efforts at home and abroad for transfer of technology to the country, he added.

Syeduzzaman prayed for salvation of the departed soul and expressed sympathy to the members of the bereaved family.

CPB rally Vice chancellors condemn bomb explosion

Vice chancellors of different universities in a joint statement yesterday strongly condemned the bomb attack on CPB's grand rally in the capital Saturday afternoon, reports UNB.

The statement issued by Bangladesh University Parishad, a forum of the VCs, said the pre-planned subversive activities are designed to create instability to thwart the democratic process.

The VCs demanded that the government take stern action and avert such heinous acts and exemplary punishment to the culprits.

They prayed for the salvation of the departed souls and early recovery of those injured.

The statement was signed by its president, Prof Abdul Bayes of Jahangirnagar University, Prof AK Azad Chowdhury of Dhaka University, Prof Nuruddin Ahmed of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, Prof Abdul Mannan of Chittagong University, Prof Saurur Rahman Khan of Rajshahi University, Prof Anwarul Islam of Bangladesh Agriculture University, Prof M Lutfur Rahman of Islamic University, SM Nazrul Islam of Khulna University, Prof Muhammad Kaesuddin of Open University, Prof Durgadas Bhattacharya of National University, Prof M Habibur Rahman of Shahjalal Science and Technology University and Prof A M Ashraful Kamal of Bangladesh University of Professionals.

In a separate statement, Bangladesh Open University Teachers' Association also expressed deep shock and condemnation over the incident.

Student bodies protest bomb attack on CPB rally

Different student organisations staged demonstration on the Dhaka University campus yesterday to protest the bomb attack on a rally of Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) at the Paltan Maidan on Saturday afternoon.

Ruling party-backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) held a rally in front of DUCSU building after parading through the campus.

Addressing the rally, BCL leaders condemned the incident and blamed anti-liberation forces for the attack.

BCL is always ready to resist the anti-liberation forces, the leaders said.

Presided over by Bahadur Bepari, the rally was addressed, among others, by Ajay Kar Khokan, Baloram Podder, Annuul Islam, Sujit Roy Nandi, Liakat Ali Sikder, Anisur Rahman, AKM Azim and Delwar Hossain.

BNP-backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) brought out a protest procession and held a rally in front of Aparajeo Bangla on the campus at noon.

Speaking at the rally, JCD leaders blamed the ruling Awami League for the incident and said, the government should resign immediately as it has failed to ensure security of the people.

Presided over by Manir Hossain, the rally was addressed, among others, by Selimuzzaman Selim, Majharul Islam Babu and Harun-or-Rashid Shishir.

Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) also brought out a procession condemning the incident. It demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of those involved in the heinous incident.

The leaders of JSD-backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) expressed deep sympathy

to the family members of those killed in the incident and said that there is link between the bomb explosion and anti-liberation forces.

Bangladesh Chhatra Federation (BCF) condemned the incident and described it as a 'pre-planned attack'.

In a statement, BCF urged the progressive forces to be united to resist the attackers.

Ganotatrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), a conglomeration of left-leaning student organisations, brought out a procession in the city and held a rally in front of National Press Club condemning the incident.

Speaking at the rally, the GCO leaders blamed Awami League government for their failure to ensure security of the people.

They demanded removal of the Home Minister and exemplary punishment to those involved in the incident.

Bar Council workshop tomorrow

JS passes Registration of Pvt Schools (Amendment) Bill

The Jatiya Sangsad yesterday passed the Registration of Private Schools (Amendment) Bill-2000, establishing its supervision and control over all types of private schools including those conducting 'O' and 'A' levels, international Baccalaureate and equivalent curriculum, reports BSS.

The bill updated, the Registration of Private Schools Ordinance, 1962 bringing all private schools under the purview of government registration including those imparting education under foreign education curriculum.

The amended bill suggested that higher secondary education will mean education pertaining to classes XI and XII and include courses equivalent to 'a' level of any foreign education curriculum.

The bill also created provisions for registration of childcare, day care and mother care centres and institutions to impart primary education with rationalized curriculum.

Education Minister ASHK Sadique piloted for the passage of the bill in the House which was adopted unanimously.

BNP protests 'false case' against its leaders
