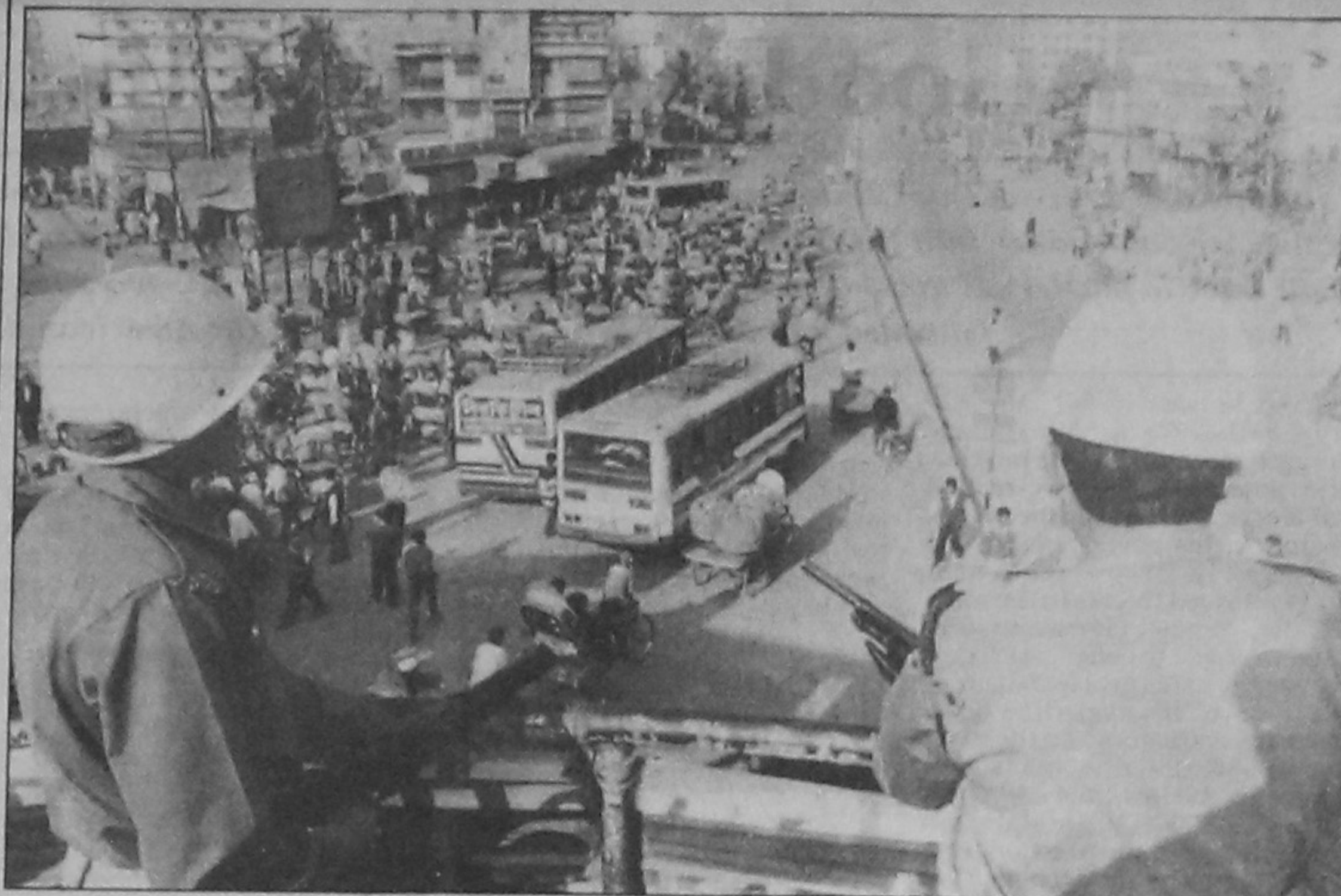

**Academic activities disrupted at DU**

Academic activities of the Dhaka University were disrupted during the BNP led four-party opposition called dawn-to-dusk hartal yesterday.

No classes or examinations were held during the last two days due to the hartals. Administrative activities were disrupted partially, sources said.

The Central Library of the university remained open but the attendance of students was thin.

The bus service of the university also did not operate during the last two days.

Meanwhile, activists of the Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) chased away Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) workers from Madhu's Canteen in the morning.

The BCL also kept vigil at every entrance of the campus to prevent JCD workers from entering the campus, sources said.

BCL also brought out a procession and held a rally at the *Aporajeo Bangla* on the campus at around 12:00 noon in protest of the hartal.

Speaking at the rally, BCL leaders said the countrymen never support the 'anti-people' hartal of the opposition alliance.

"The intention behind the hartal is nothing but to destroy the country's democracy and obstruct the development process," they said.

The BCL also announced that they will resist any conspiracy of the anti-liberation forces at any cost.

Presided over by Bahadur Bepari, the rally was addressed, among others, by Ajay Kar Khokan, Aminul Islam, Llakat Ali Sikder, Anisur Rahman, Rafiqul Islam, Khalid Mahmud Chowdhury and AKM Azim.
