Tears of Fire : Crying Out for Justice

A video documentary by Mrityunjoy Roy Senu holds up the plea for an International war tribunal to try the criminals who masterminded the genocide in Bangladesh in 1971

It is very sad that little has been done to try the war criminals of 1971. The few documentaries that have been

made have focused on the liberation war itself and the cruel violence that marked the struggle for our independence.

Amidst this when someone comes up with a good piece of work, not just content wise but

also in its making, than that certainly deserves some attention. 'Tears of Fire' is such a video documentary by young director Mrityunjoy Roy Senu.

The 30 minute documentary is a piece of work that searches

the genocide that claimed the lives of three million people of the country. Mrityunjoy Roy traces the atrocious attack of the Pakistani army on the innocent masses of the country. He tries to depict in his documentary how

Another participant is Prof Benjamin N French, the last surviving prosecutor of the Nuremberg trial and a person who has always lent voice to the holding of a similar trial for Bangladesh's war, R K Taylor one of the human rights activists who initiated the blockade against the Pakistani ship that was to carry the weapons from the US military for use in the genocide back here, Phyllis Taylor, another activist who organised, street dramas, street songs, rallies and the like to make the people in the west aware of the atrocities being done in Bangladesh. Another participant is Dr William Greenough the founder of the Bangladesh Information Centre that provided the photographs, news and documents to the Senators and congressmen in the US and American people at large.

There is also an interview with a war widow, a war orphan and their people intimately involved with the war, who explained the irreparable losses they suffered and how they feel about

those responsible for such brutal acts having gone unpunished in such a civilized world.

Tears of Fire is not a ground breaking documentary that will make everyone sit up and take

notice about it. But it is a well made film that will nevertheless claim the attentions of a lot of people in this country who too are asking for a trial of those brutal men who heinously carried out the genocide and have still gone scott free with blood on their hands.

Roy has done a commendable task of putting forward the sentiments of the people in their demand for a, International Tribunal to try the people who masterminded the human tragedy in 1971. The documentary in its 30 minute layout has neatly been put together in its script, and narration to present its say to the people. The editing is excellent, especially if compared to many other documentaries being produced in a haste who don't pay much attention to the finishing of a short film. The sound effects are also neat.

Mrityunjoy Roy Senu shows promise of becoming of a good filmmaker as his first amateur venture with such a delicate topic shows. Tears of Fire will remain a milestone in his career in any case.

At present the documentary is available on the CD-ROM brought out by the Liberation War Museum in its introduction of the Liberation War of our country.


14th National Art Exhibition

the barbaric Pak regime had attacked the people without provocation and takes help from different people who were involved with important parts of the war at that time.

What Roy has tried to do is present the extent of the cruelty that was carried out to support the plea for a War Tribunal to try the criminals who have gone without punishment so far.

The film unfolds with the documentation of how the war broke out, leading slowly to the genocide that the country experienced. There are still many people around this world who are yet unaware about the massive human tragedy that took place right in this country with the approval and under the commands of another nation that claimed to have a democratic government at that time. Roy interviewed international figures who were involved in our war, either in trying to get us help from abroad, or by making information available to the outside world about the in-depth of the genocide being carried out here.
