Asma Kibria's painting show opens in city

A 17-day long solo painting exhibition titled "Rupashi Bangla" by Asma Kibria began at National Museum in the city yesterday, reports BSS.
Speaking as chief guest at the inaugural ceremony, former chief of the caretaker government Justice Muhammad Habibur Rahman said Asma is unique in her work for her 'inventive shapes, cheerful rhythms and beautiful harmonious colours.'
Justice Rahman said artists of the new generation will get inspiration from her works. Use of bright colours, specially the prominent presence of blue, in her paintings makes a different kind of appeal, he observed.
Noted painters Mohammad Kibria and Hashem Khan also spoke as special guests at the function. Director General of National Museum Shamsuzzaman Khan presided.
Finance Minister Shah A M S Kibria, economist Rehan Sobhan, Chairman of Ekusey TV A S Mahmud, industrialist Salman F Rahman and a number of leading personalities in different fields were present at the function.
Shamsuzzaman Khan said Asma expressed the beauty of the traditional Bangladesh with her brush while poet Jibanananda Das had expressed it through his writings. She has depicted the country's nature with a deep sense of appreciation though she has trained abroad, he said.
The exhibition will remain open from 9:30 am to 8:30 pm everyday except government holidays. A total of 54 paintings are on display.
Asma, wife of Finance Minister Shah A M S Kibria, began her stint with painting in 1962 with a three-year training at an art school in New York headed by Peter Baboux.

Motia calls for movement against social ills

Agriculture Minister Begun Motia Chowdhury yesterday urged people to launch a movement against social ills, including adoption of unfair means in examinations and gambling, reports BSS.
She was addressing a national seminar on "Child rights and human development in Bangladesh," organised by Bangladesh Literacy Society (BLS) at the National Press Club as chief guest.
Presided over by former education secretary Kazi Fazlur Rahman, the seminar was also addressed by former Finance Minister Saifur Rahman MP, Health Secretary Syed Alamgir Faruq Chowdhury, Dr Mizanur Rahman Shelley, Prof Osman Ghani, secretary general of BLS, Ambassador of Sweden Sven Anders Johnson, Dr Kazi Saleh Ahmed, former vice-chancellor of Jahangirnagar University, Reaz Uddin Ahmed, Chief Editor of the Financial Express, Charge d'Affaires of Danish Embassy Ove Fritz Larsen, Charge d'Affaires, European Commission J.V. Ketelsen and Munirul Haq, Editor of the Economic Times.
The agriculture minister dwelt at length on the achievements of the government of Sheikh Hasina in different fields like education, health, rural development and agriculture.
Regarding the establishment of child rights and human development, she said it is not possible for the government alone to achieve this rather it requires collective efforts of the NGOs. She also said the government has given specific guidelines for human resource development for reducing the rate of poverty.
The minister said there has been favourable impact in social sectors, including increase in the rate of literacy and generation of rural employment opportunity, following pragmatic steps taken by the government during its four and a half years' rule.
Dr Kazi Saleh Ahmed was critical of the strategies taken in the past for development saying, "we have failed to give due attention to human development resulting in increase in the number of the country's poor. He said the rate of return from investment in the education sector is higher, than in other sectors."
He suggested linking education with productivity. He expressed concern over difficulties for rural students to have access to higher education in urban areas. In the process, he said, in future they will be deprived of any employment opportunity.

An international conference on Bangladesh parliament will be held in the city on February 3 to discuss future reforms in the country's parliamentary system.
The day-long conference titled "Bangladesh Parliament in the 21st century" will focus on a wide range of issues which are critical to improving the functions of the parliament, says a press release.
Bangladesh Parliament Secretariat in association with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the World Bank is organising the conference.
Former prime minister of India I K Gujral, former speaker of the Indian Lok Sabha P A Sangma and chairman of Foreign Affairs committee of the Belgian parliament Geert Versnick will present keynote papers in the conference.
Speaker Hunayun Rasheed Chowdhury, Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad, Finance Minister Shah A M S Kibria, former finance minister M Saifur Rahman, former speaker Shaikli Razzaq Ali and a number of lawmakers will take part in the discussion.
The conference will have three-panel sessions under the titles: (a) Towards greater accountability to parliament, (b) Representing the citizens, reform and prospects and (c) Do Law makers make the laws?
