Tofail to attend symposium on LDCs' trade

After a year of hibernation arising out of the trouble at Seattle meeting of WTO, international organisations have renewed their efforts to improve LDCs' trade, reports BSS.

As part of their initiatives, UNCTAD together with Norwegian Government has organised a two-day symposium on "The role of the private sector in enhancing productive capacity in LDCs" in Oslo on January 29-30.

World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) in cooperation with the Portugal Government has also organised a high-level international roundtable on intellectual property for LDCs in Lisbon on February 1-2.

Industries Minister Tofail Ahmed, who has been playing an important role in establishing the rights of LDCs in various international forum, left Dhaka Saturday night to attend the meetings.

The Industries Minister will present a key-note speech at the symposium. The main objective of the symposium is to provide an opportunity for the governments of LDCs, their development partners and representatives of the private sector to discuss the role of the private sector.

The objectives of the conference are - to reflect upon people's understanding of genocide, to bring together the narratives of the genocide perpetuated in different parts of the world during different phases of history and to understand genocidal mentality and how it involves not only regimes but also ordinary citizens, professionals, security experts, who apparently do not support genocide.

Int'l confce on Genocide in Dhaka Jan 13-14, 2002

Bangladesh will host an International Conference on Genocide on January 2002, the first of its kind in the world.

Liberation War Museum (LWM), Centre for Alternatives (CA) and Centre for the Study of Developing Societies (CSDS), Delhi will jointly organise the programme on January 13 and 14, 2002 in collaboration with other regional and international centres and institutes.

This was disclosed in the concluding ceremony of a two-day preparatory meeting leading to the conference yesterday at a city hotel.

The objectives of the conference are - to reflect upon people's understanding of genocide, to bring together the narratives of the genocide perpetuated in different parts of the world during different phases of history and to understand genocidal mentality and how it involves not only regimes but also ordinary citizens, professionals, security experts, who apparently do not support genocide.

Seminar on naming of India

A US academician researching on the history of the Subcontinent said at the beginning of the 20th century some adopted the term Hindustan to mean India to distinguish those areas to be controlled by a future Hindu-dominated government from those to be ruled by a Muslim-majority one, reports BSS.

This was observed by Dr Ian Jeffrey Barrow, Assistant Professor, Department of History, Middlebury College, Vermont.

He was addressing a seminar titled "From Hindustan to India: Naming Change in Changing Name" organised by AIBS in the city on Saturday. Dr Mizanur Rahman Shelley, Overseas Director of AIBS, presided over the seminar.

In his paper Dr Barrow pointed out that Hindustan's bewildering variety of meaning - Mughal domain or Company land; all of India or just northern India, for example - made it increasingly unfit as a suitable term for geographical region.

The implication of this argument is that colonial British use of the term Hindustan and later India helped transform what was first seemingly indeterminate, divided and little known political entities into a discrete geographical space, he

noted. "The transformation by foreign cartographers and colonial officials, expressed so simply, as a change in name, had important ramifications," he said. In his presidential address Dr Shelley said Hindustan or "Blarbarsha", denoting the South Asian subcontinent, is the abode of many races and nationalities, and in recent times it has been trisected to house three sovereign states - Bangladesh, India and Pakistan.

But the inhabitants of these three politically distinct entities have a common civilisational heritage, he noted.

It is, therefore, necessary for them to be aware of the scholarly analyses of the change and transformation of the names by which this region has been described through centuries of moving history, he added.

Dr Nazrul Islam and Dr Ziaur Shams, professors of Geography Department, Dhaka University, Fouzia E Ahmed, Fellow of AIBS, Dr Enamul Haq, former DG of National Museum, K M Rabbani, former Secretary, Bangladesh Chair of History Department, Dhaka University, Enayet Karim, Director of AIBS and Arif Iqbal Mizan of CDRB, also took part in the discussion.
