BMSF JU unit signature collection campaign. Bangladesh Manobadhikar Khabar Forum (BMSF) Jahangirnagar University unit, has undertaken a three-day-long signature collection campaign from today (Monday) demanding free treatment of UNB's Feni Correspondent Tipu Sultan.

Tipu was brutally beaten up allegedly by the cadres of Feni's 'don' Joyal Hazari on January 25. He is now undergoing treatment at Pangu Hospital in Dhaka.

ADB to provide \$67.8m for flood rehabilitation project. Bangladesh will receive \$7.8 million US dollars from Asian Development Bank (ADB) for implementing its Southwest Flood Damage Rehabilitation Project.

The project will rehabilitate national, regional and feeder roads, embankments and drainage facilities, railways, community sanitation and water supply facilities and seed multiplication farms.
