Malaysia to build free trade zone near Thai border

AFP, Kuala Lumpur

A free-trade industrial zone costing three billion ringgit (789 million dollars) is to be developed near the Malaysia/Thailand border over the next decade, a senior official said Thursday.

The ASEAN Industrial Metropolis covering 2,400 hectares (5,928 acres) will be built at Bukit Kayu Hitam in the northwestern Malaysian state of Kedah, the state's chief minister Syed Razak Sved Zain said.

The zone will include areas for heavy industry and small and medium industries, an immigration and Customs complex, a commercial centre and housing, Bernama news agency quoted him as say-

It is scheduled for completion in 2010.

"When fully operational, the project will attract investments worth 20 billion ringgit and create 20,000 job opportunities for locals and Thais," he told reporters.

Prime Minister Mahathir Mohamad is expected to preside at a ground-breaking ceremony on March 5.


