

Batsman Mark Waugh will be interviewed on Saturday by investigators probing cricket's betting and match-rigging scandal as he prepares to leave for India with the Australian team.

The twin brother of Australian captain Steve Waugh and a star batsman in his own right, Mark Waugh is at the centre of the storm that has cast a dark pall over his career and a cloud over the allconquering Australian cricket

The subcontinent is where Waugh first became mired in the scandal, and where Waugh and the Australian team begin a threematch Test series in Mumbai on February 27.

The key allegations being investigated by a lawver representing the Australian Cricket Board (ACB). Greg Melick, and the International Cricket Council (ICC) against Waugh were made by In-

dian bookmaker Mukesh Gupta. Gupta told Indian police that Waugh accepted 20,000 US dollars in payments from him in return for team, weather and pitch information in the early 1990s.
