AFP, New Delhi

India plans to organise a fournation limited-overs tournament in April to raise funds for victims of the devastating earthquake in Gujarat, the country's cricket chief said on Friday.

AC Muthiah, president of the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI), said the likely teams. dates and venues will be finalised on the sidelines of the meeting of the International Cricket Council in Melbourne this weekend.

"I will be talking to officials from other countries in Melbourne and explore the possibilities of organising a tournament to raise funds for an important cause," Muthiah told this nerws agency.

Muthiah said Australia, South Africa, New Zealand, Sri Lanka and Zimbabwe were likely to be approached to play in the tournament.

Muthiah sidetracked a question on whether Pakistan, whose offer to play in a fund-raising event in Sharjah this month was rebuffed by the Indian government, would be approached.
