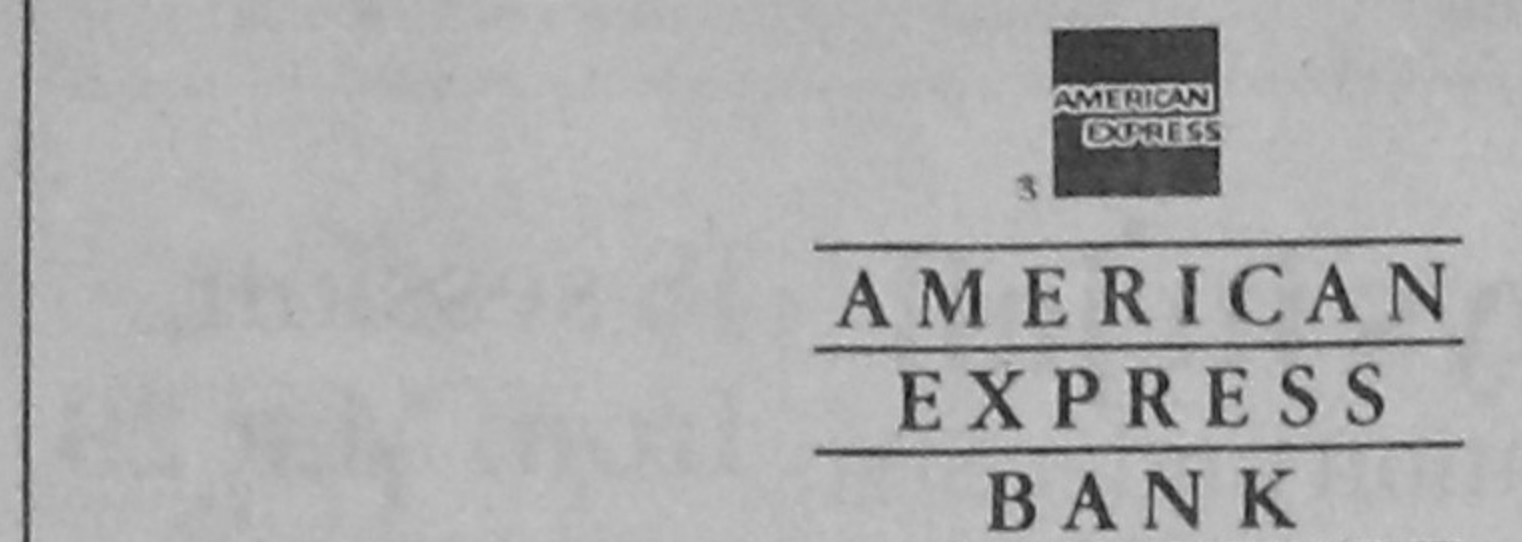

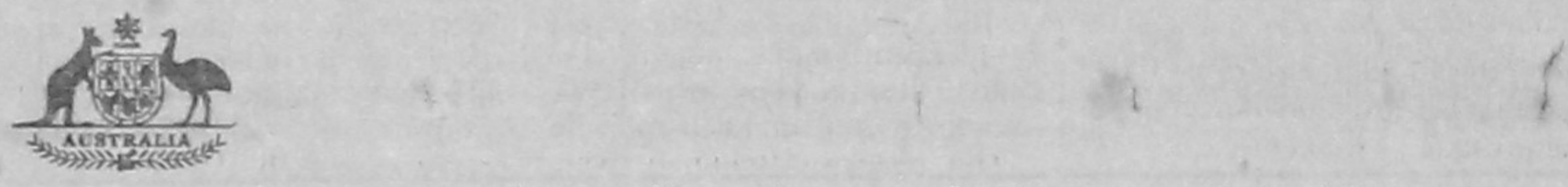

Australian Development Scholarships (ADS) - 2002 Intake
Open Category

As part of the Australian Government's ongoing commitment to human resource development in Bangladesh, the Australian Agency for International Development (AusAID) is pleased to invite applications from private individuals for study in Australia in 2002. (Government officers are considered under the Public category and should direct their enquiries to F & F Division, Economic Relations Division, Blk 16, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, Dhaka.) Before deciding to apply, candidates should take note of the following conditions and requirements:

- Fields of study offered for 2002 intake will be: (i) Agricultural Science; (ii) Business Administration; (iii) Computer Science; (iv) Development Economics; (v) Education; (vi) Environmental Studies; (vii) Public Health; (viii) Teaching English as a Second Language (TESOL). Awards will be offered for studies at Masters level only.
- Fifty percent of all scholarships will be reserved for female candidates. In addition, targeted scholarships will be available for female and male candidates of tribal descent.
- All candidates must:
 - be less than 40 years old on 1 January 2002;
 - have completed a minimum of four years of tertiary level studies with;
 - no third class results in any examination for tribal (targeted) applicants; and
 - first class results in all examinations for all other (untargeted) applicants.
 - nominate a field of study relevant to their current employment. Applicants must select only one field of study. Applicants are not allowed to change the field of study once they are short-listed.
- Candidates fulfilling the above conditions must submit a written application in English on plain paper along with a curriculum-vitae (CV) and 2 (two) passport size photographs (attested). The CV must contain (a) name; (b) date of birth; (c) present address and telephone number; (d) permanent address and telephone number; (e) employment details (past & present); (f) educational qualifications including (i) name of examination, (ii) Board / University, (iii) year of graduation, (iv) Division/Class, (v) total marks with percentages; and (g) name of two referees. Copies of all certificates and marksheets (duly attested) must be attached. Applicants must submit a typewritten statement stating why they have selected this field of study and how the proposed course of study will benefit them on return to Bangladesh. Applications and attachments will not be returned.
- Applicants applying for Business Administration must have two years of relevant work experience, and also provide evidence. Applicants with MBBS degrees must attach marksheets of all professional exams, internship completion reports and registration certificate. Applicants of tribal descent must submit a certificate of tribal descent duly signed by the respective Deputy Commissioner.
- All applicants should provide documentation on A4 size paper and clearly indicate the name and position of the person who has certified the records. Documents should be attested by any First Class Government Gazetted officer or any person of an equal status. Applications with incomplete documentation, faulty or false information will be rejected.
- Short-listed candidates must sit an IELTS test in May 2001. Applicants who are not available to sit for the test on the nominated date, or who cannot be contacted, will be disqualified. Candidates must obtain a minimum overall IELTS score of 6.5. Intending candidates are strongly encouraged to prepare themselves in advance for this test.
- All awardees are required to commence their studies in January 2002. Deferrals will not be granted. Dependents (applicants' spouse and children) will be allowed to join awardees in Australia six weeks after commencement of studies.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have not previously undertaken post-graduate studies abroad.
- No calls or correspondences will be entertained regarding the status of applications. Successful applicants will be advised of the date for IELTS in May. All applicants are advised to enclose a self-addressed envelope (size 110 x 220 mm). Unsuccessful applicants (who enclose an envelope) will be advised by mail in July of the outcome of their application.
- Applications should be sent to the First Secretary (Development Assistance), Australian High Commission, 184 Gulshan Avenue, Dhaka 1212. Applicants must specify the category and the subject applied for on top of the CVs as well as on the envelope containing the application. The deadline for submission of applications is 29 March 2001. Any application received after 3:45 PM on this date will not be considered.
