## Gruesome murder Identity of victim couldn't be known yet

Identity of the middle-aged man whose body was chopped into twelve pieces and dumped into a manhole at North Goran in the city's Khilgaon area could not be known till last night.

Hospital sources said that several people visited the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) morgue since the recovery of the body two days back but failed to identify the victim of the gruesome murder. The body was sent to Anjuman-e-Mafidul Islam for burial.

The mutilated body was recovered by police from North Goran in Khilgaon area on Thursday morning.

Khilgaon thana received no complaint or any details about the victim till writing of this report last night. Duty officer of Khilgaon thana said that they were trying to find out the identity of the victim.

Miscrants cut the body of the man, believed to be in his forties, into 12 pieces and dumped it into the manhole inside House 304, North Goran.

The strategy of the campaign will be adopted in the first meeting of the newly elected Central Command Council of Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Sangsad, its Chairman Principal Abdul Ahad Chowdhury told UNB.

As the parliamentary election is in the offing, he said, Sangsad's overall position over the crucial polls will also be decided in the meeting.

The meeting will be held shortly

after Eid-ul-Azha.

Sangsad's stand on the general elections, however, will have to be approved by its executive body, that also includes commanders of all district councils.

The 41-member new central command council was elected on

February 27.

The first meeting of the Muktiyoddha Sangsad will also distribute the portfolios of the 15 elected secretaries.
