

124 in the space of 27 balls. Compounding Pakistan's woes was the absence of experienced opener Saeed Anwar, who didn't bat after injuring his groin while

fielding Sunday. Drum ended with eight wickets for the match after second-innings figures of four for 42, while Penn took three wickets Monday to end with four for 44 and seven for the match.

Pakistan trailed by 70 runs Monday, and it took until just the third over for New Zealand A to make further inroads.

Penn took wickets in successive balls when he bowled Younis Khan for four then had Mushtaq Ahmed caught by Lou Vincent at third slip.




