Commemorating Prophet Ibrahim's offer to sacrifice his beloved son, Ismail, in submission to the will of Almighty Allah, millions of Muslims joined morning congregations of prayers in eid-gahs and mosques and sacrificed animals for divine blessings.

The devotees prayed for temporal and eternal wellbeing as well as for peace, unity and prosperity of the Muslim Ummah.

In the capital, the main Eid congregation was held at the National Eidgah at 8 am where President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed offered prayers.

Chief Justice Mahmudul Amin Chowdhury, ministers, MPs, judges, politicians, elite and diplomats of Muslim countries also offered their Eid prayers with the President.

As in previous years, the City Corporation made special arrangements for women to say their Eid prayers at the National Eidgah.

Muslims exchanged Eid greetings by embracing each other. Muslims sacrificed animals and distributed meat among the poor and friends and relations

after the prayer session.

President hosted receptions to diplomats and local elites separately at Bangabhaban in the morning. He exchanged Eid greetings with the invitees.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is now in Saudi Arabia for performing holy Hajj. Leader of the Opposition in Parliament Begum Khaleida Zia also held an Eid reception at 29 Minto Road.

Meanwhile, the Dhaka City Corporation has requested the city-dwellers to clean up their respective areas after sacrificing the animals.

A three-day Eid vacation began Tuesday and the recess will be elongated with a two-day weekend.
