England's resurgent cricketers pulled off a 2-1 series victory over Sri Lanka when they won the third and last Test by four wickets in a compelling finish on Saturday.

Nasser Hussain's touring team needed just 74 to win after they skittled Sri Lanka for 81 in their second innings but were forced to endure a tense finale before reaching the target late on the third day.

England stumbled to 43 for four at one stage as Michael Atherton (13), Marcus Trescothick (10), Michael Vaughan (8) and Alec Stewart (0) fell to a combination of pace from Dilhara Fernando and the spin of Sanath Jayasuriya and Muttiah Muralitheran.

However, Graham Thorpe coolly steered his side home with 32 not out after earlier completing an outstanding unbeaten 113, a performance that earned him the man-of-the-match award.

England's success with two



days to spare means they have now won four consecutive Test series: Zimbabwe 1-0 and West Indies 3-1 at home last year, Pakistan 1-0 away in December and now Sri Lanka 2-1 after losing the first Test.
