Eight young artists' show attracts art lovers' attention

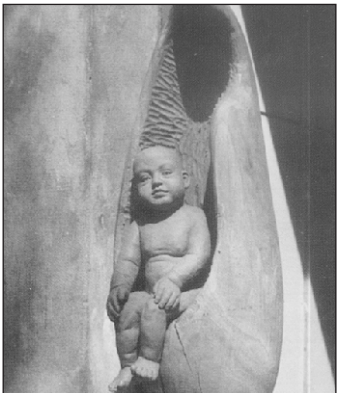

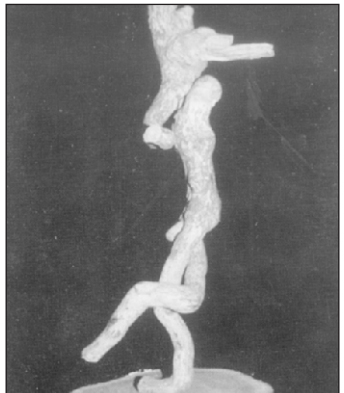

Mother and Child Ranget Karmakar



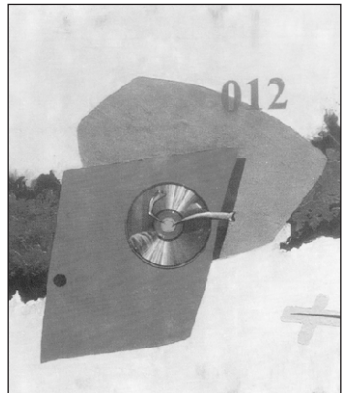

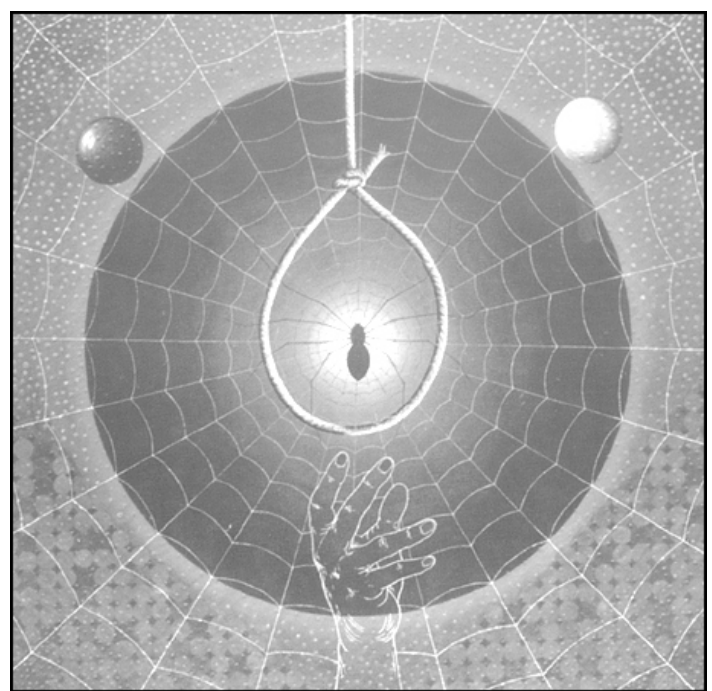

Three-day film festival highlighting the great German city begins today

THE city of Berlin is one of the most interesting and well-known city's in the world. It has been in the limelight in recent times for symbolically triggering off the breakdown of the communist era, and subsequently leading to the reunion of the East and West Germany.

Berlin, is a city of many happenings and sands witness to some of the most important events of modern history.

In a tribute to this charming city of the world, Zahir Raihan Film Society begins a three-day film festival today, titled focus on Berlin: Documentary and Feature Films and will be screening some of the most famous films and documentaries ever made on the city.

These films deal with life in Berlin, its social, cultural architectural, theatrical, artistic and political aspects. These different films puts

Screening of two more films *The Murderers are Among Us* (81 mins) by Wolfgang Staudte at 5.30 pm will be held on the second day of the festival. This is the first German Film after the war and tells the story of a woman seeking the truth in the harsh world of reality following the war, the next film *Life is All You Get* (118 mins) by Wolfgang Becker at 7.00 pm.

On the last day of the show, Helmar Harald, Fishcer's documentary film *Berlin's Theatre: Schaubuhne* (90 mins) will mark the beginning of screening at 5.30 in the afternoon. This will be followed by Ulrike Kahle's *Berlin's Theatre:*

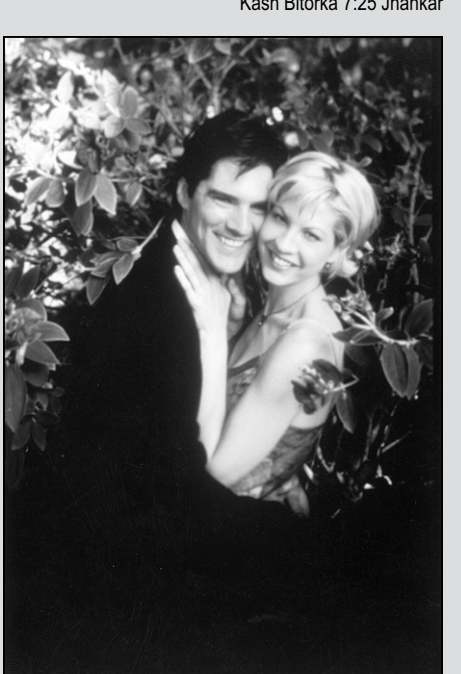
