Students of the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of Bangladesh (ICMAB) brought out a procession in the city yesterday demanding immediate release of 18 students of ICMAB who were arrested under PSA recently.

**Unrest at institute
ICMAB students
demand govt
intervention**

The students of Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of Bangladesh (ICMAB) yesterday demanded immediate release of 18 students, arrested under Public Safety Act (PSA) and withdrawal of 'false cases' against them.

The students, under the banner of 'Adhikar Bastobayan Parishad', also demanded immediate resumption of the date of examinations by the institute.

In a press conference yesterday, the students urged the President, Prime Minister, Commerce Minister and Home Minister to intervene into the recent incident that took place at the institution.

Among others, Kutu Mahmud, Bakhtiar Alam, Ziaur Shams Biplob, Matiuur Rahman Tasfin and Nahida Akhter addressed the press conference.

The ICMAB authorities have

said that police arrested 18 persons in the early hours of Monday from the ICMAB campus, to control the situation prevailing there at the time. Police also took the councilors and employees of the institute before registering a general diary in this regard, said.

In a statement yesterday, the authorities also claimed that students ransacked windowpanes and threw water bottles on the council members during a meeting on March 18 and later held hostage the council members and other employees when both parties failed to reach any consensus over students' demand.

The meeting was held over students demand including removal of Hasnan Ahmed, the additional director of the institute and establishment of a canteen of the institute, the statement added.

The institution has been closed since die after the incident.

**Biman regrets
inconveniences
caused to hajis**

Biman Bangladesh Airlines yesterday regretted inconvenience caused to the returnee hajis for delays in flight operation due to congestion at the Jeddah Airport, a Biman press release said.

The national flag carrier has already started operating two more flights one yesterday and another today to carry the hajis back home beyond its schedule from March 19 to 19. Biman operated 59 return hajj flights this year, the press release said.

Due to aircraft congestion at the Jeddah Airport, each return flight of Biman reached the airport 12 to 18 hours behind the schedule and also took much more time for embarkation and disembarkation of passengers.

For this reason, the first return flight of Biman had to spend at least 12 hours time in accomplishing all formalities. All the followed-up flights suffered the same delay, the press release said.

Biman authorities will soon take up due measures to avoid such inconveniences in future, the release added.
