T&T bills for Jan, Feb delayed

The telephone bills for the month of January and February of Bangladesh Telephone and Telegraph Board (BTTB) will be issued in the first half of April.

BTTB officials told BSS yesterday that the bills for the months would be issued one after another as BTTB with technical assistance from Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) has started preparing the bills at its own computer centre at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar.

Officials said the unwanted delay in issuing bill is caused due to the expiry of BTTB's contract on printing phone bills with a private firm - Lithi Enterprise on January 31 this year.

The selection of another printing firm was stalled following a court injunction as Lithi Enterprise filed a case against BTTB. Later the court vacated the injunction and BTTB decided to print the bill at its own computer centre, officials said.
