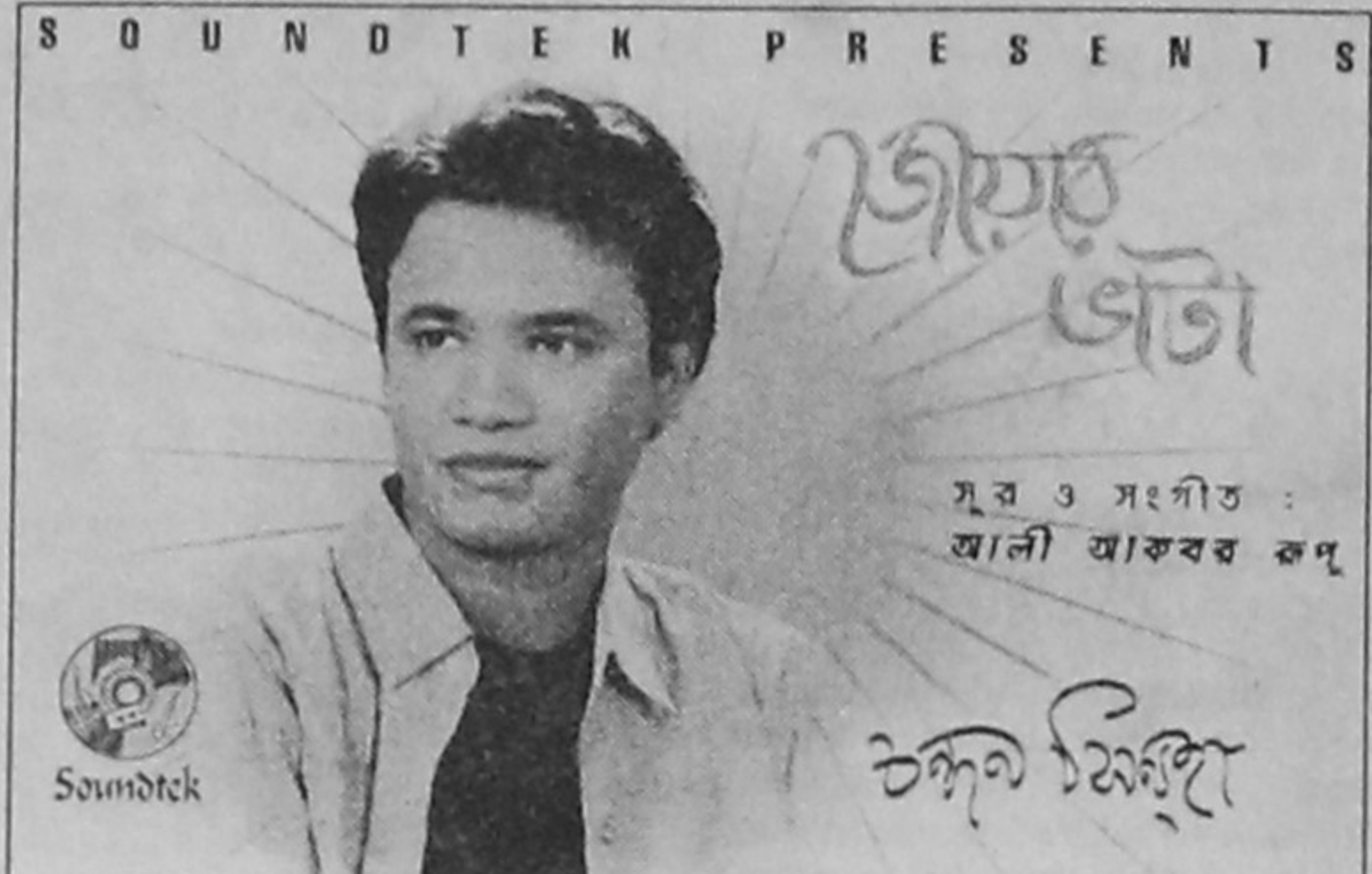

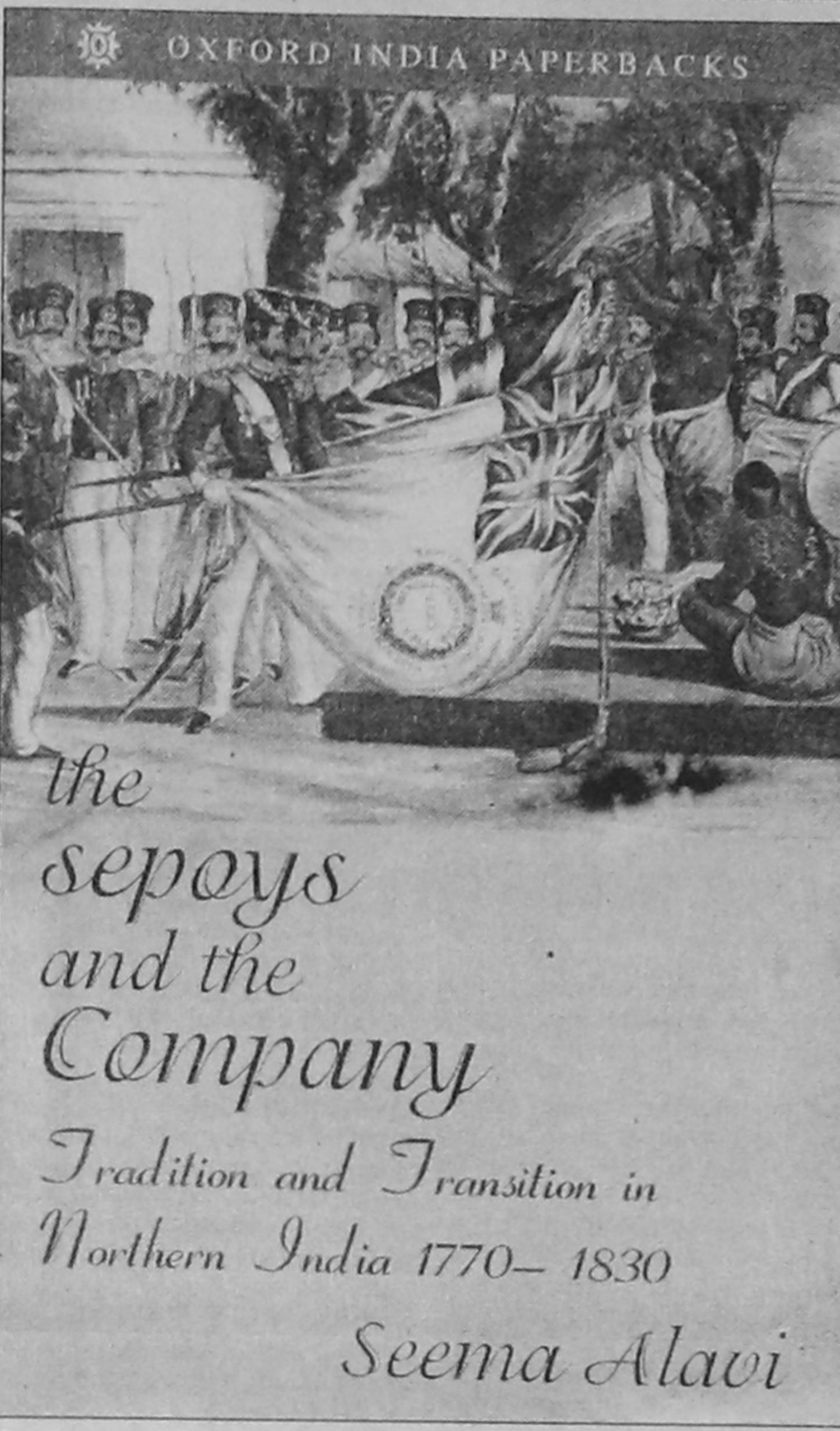

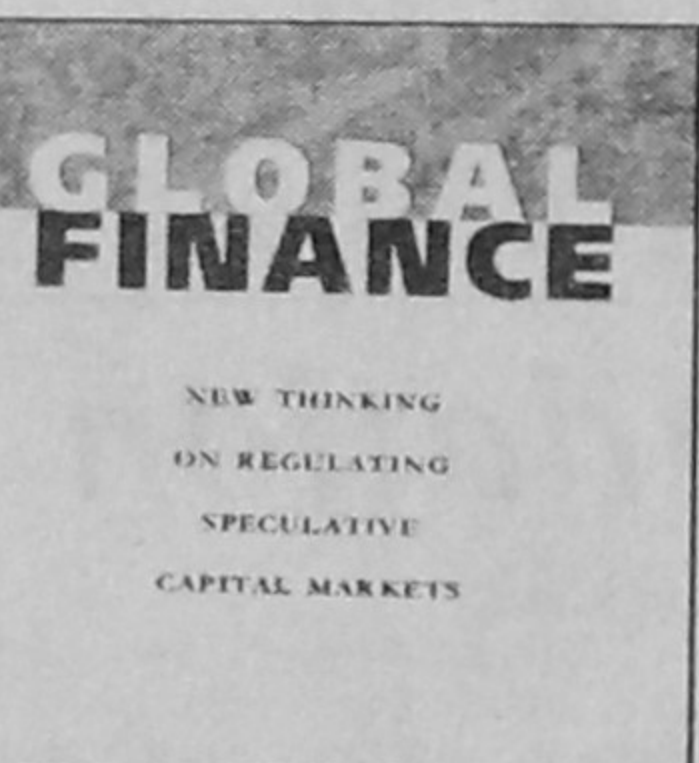


Fabulous Flute of Hariprasad Chaurasia

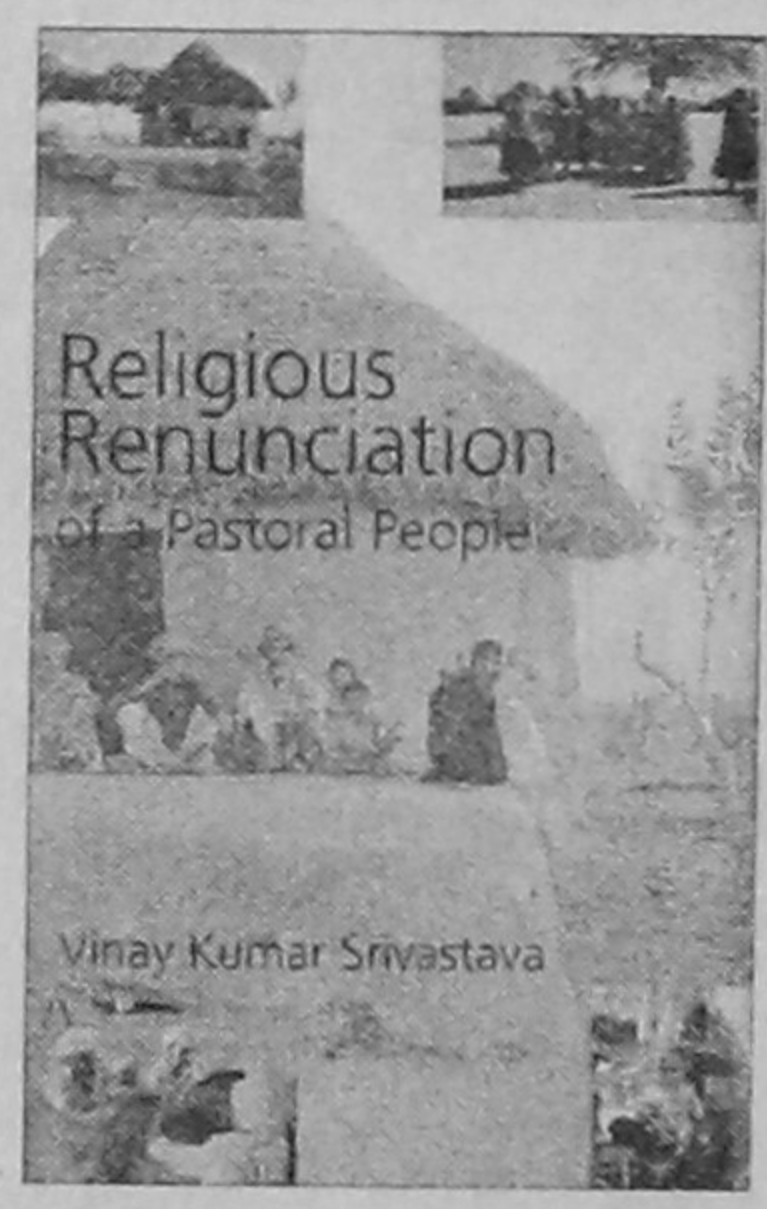

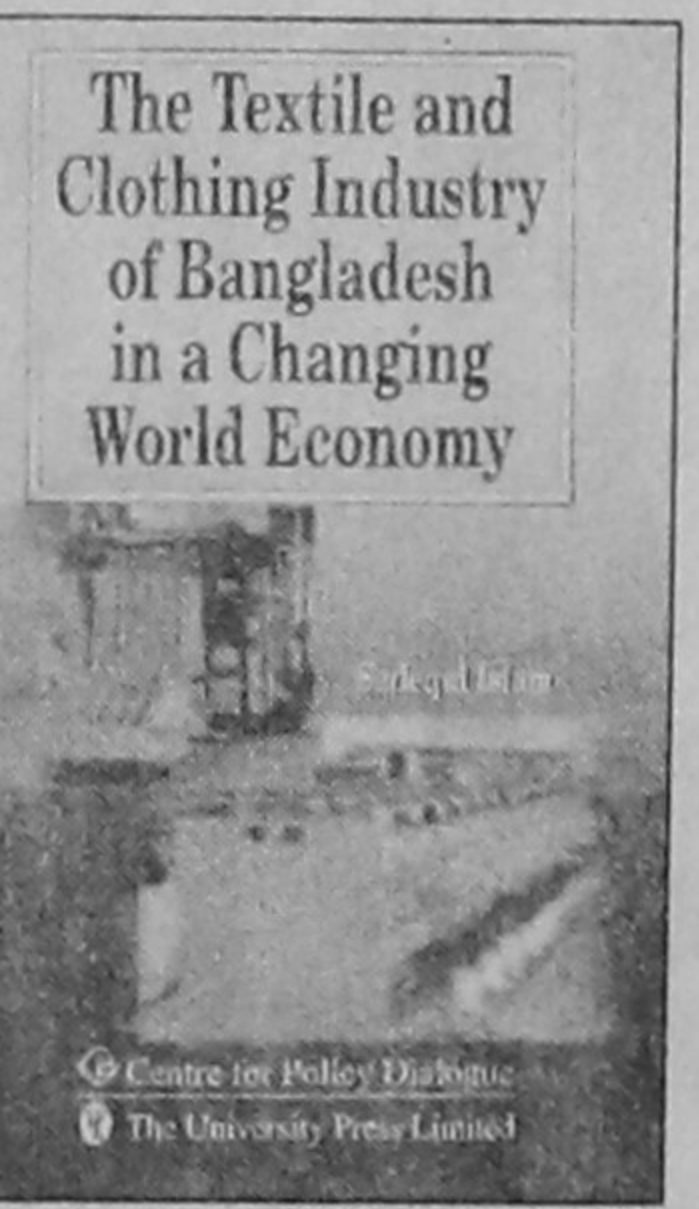
The Sepoys and the Company

In this important policy-and-campaign-relevant book, economists, intellectuals and NGO leaders from both North and South confront what has now become the central issue of the new globalised world economy.



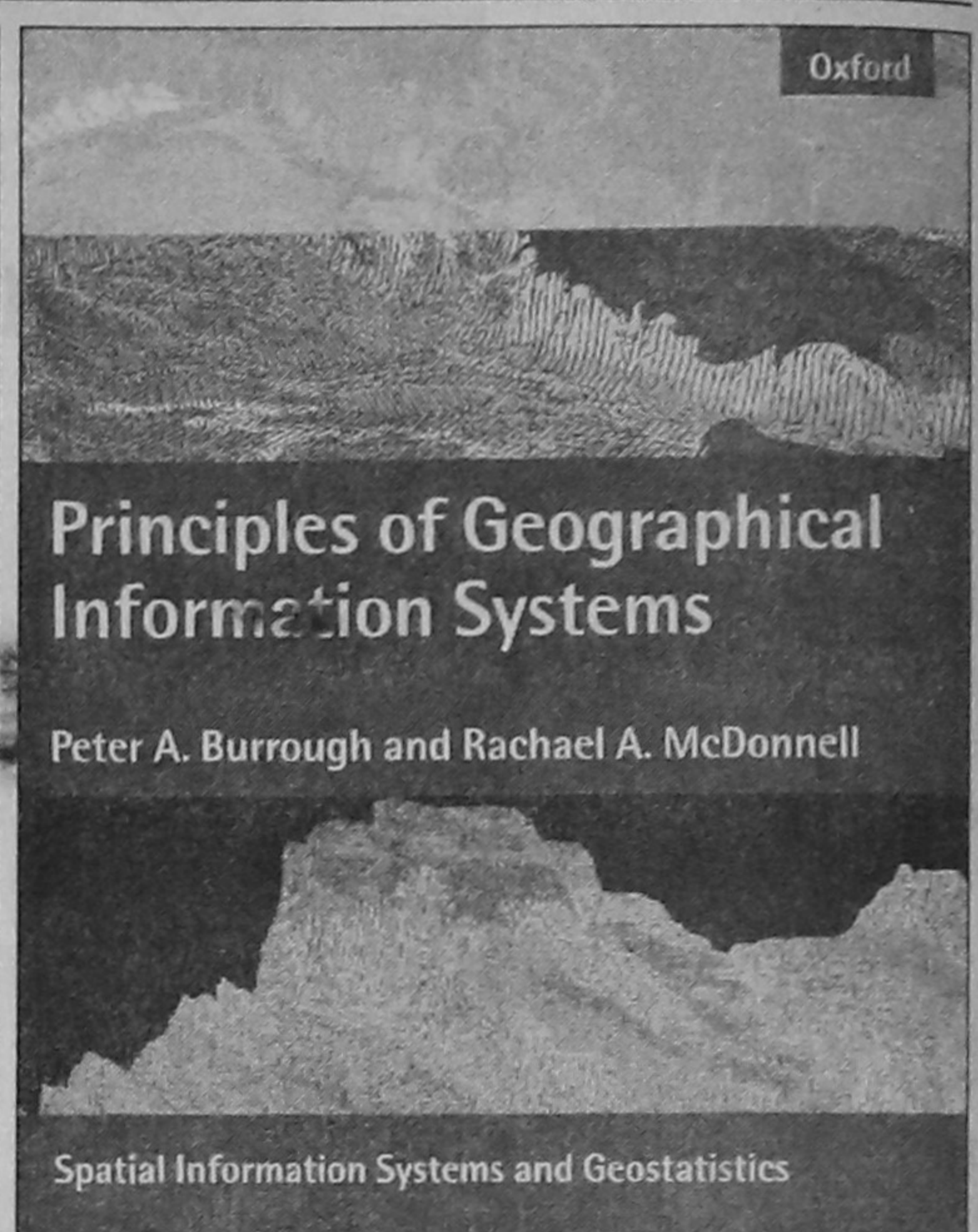
Religious Renunciation of a Pastoral People

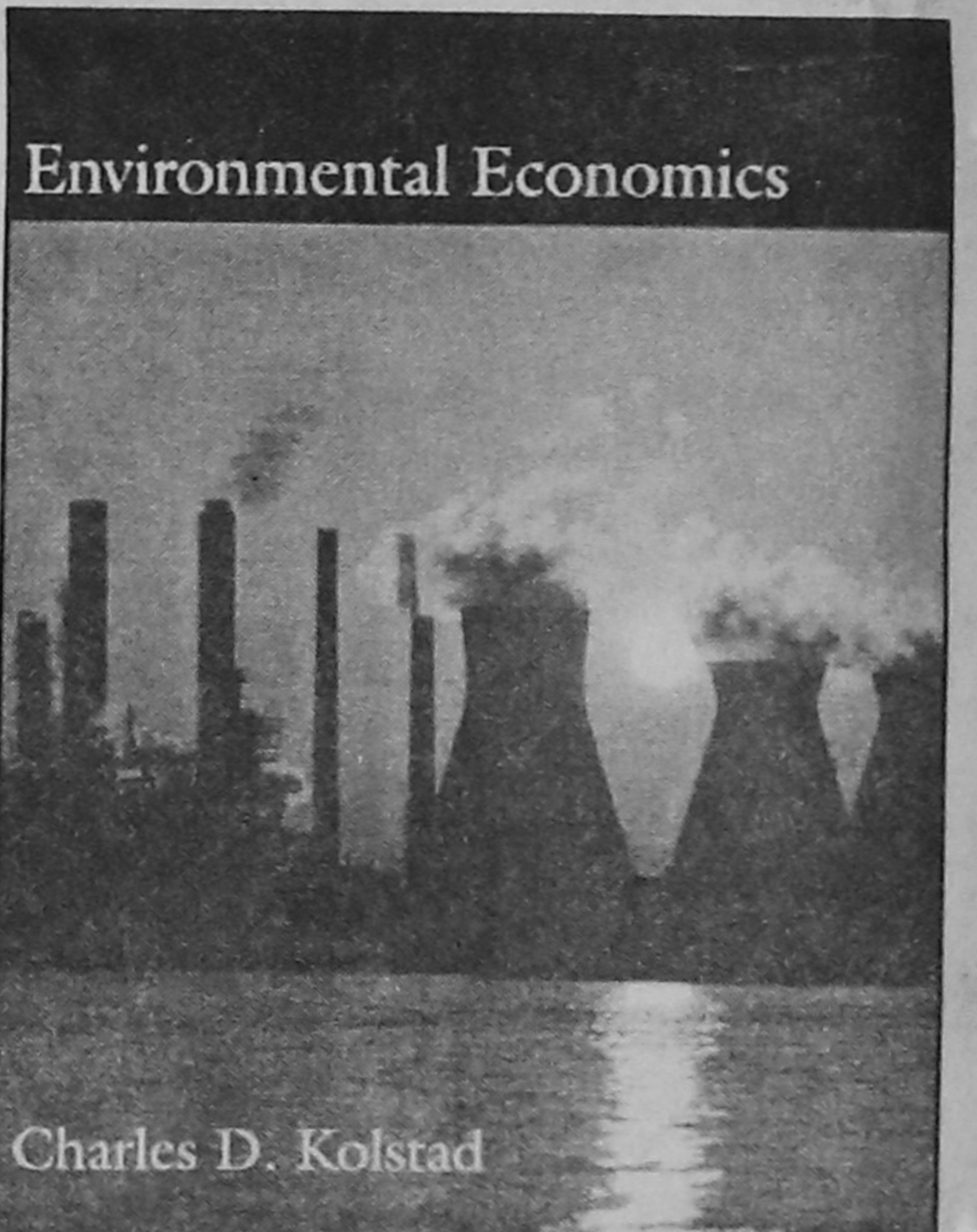
The Textile and Clothing Industry of Bangladesh in a Changing World Economy

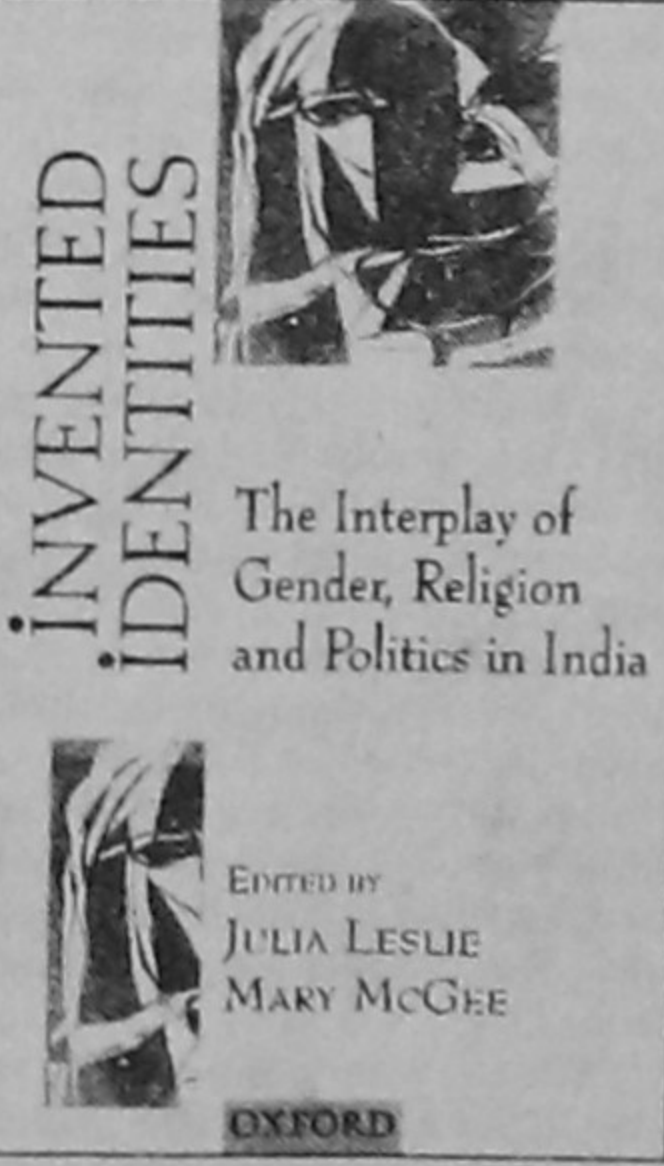
Islam: Basic Beliefs

The book will satisfy the pressing need of the modern Muslims to keep themselves abreast with the basic belief in Islam mentioned in the Qur'an and the Hadith.



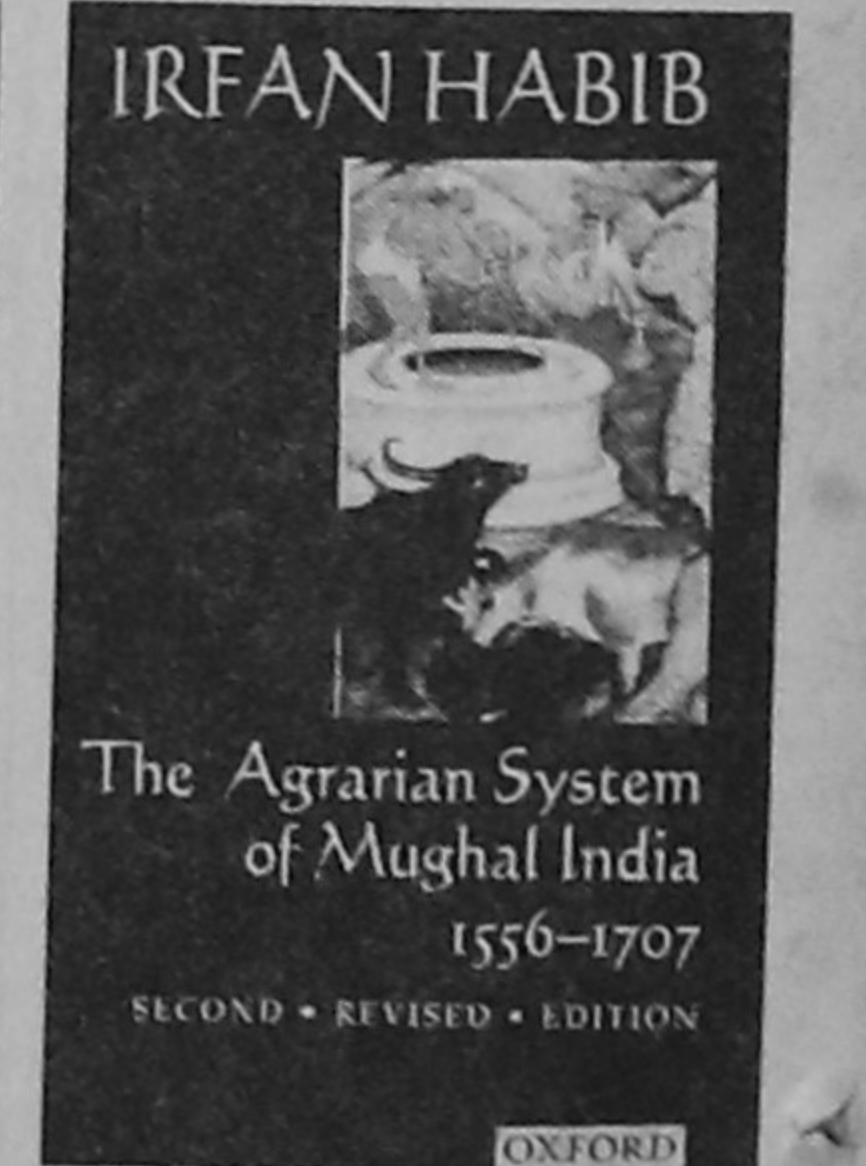
Principles of Geographical Information Systems
