

The advantage of a foreign brand is the high standard of PC components being used. Proper testing of components is done before a product is assembled and sold. On the other hand, one of the disadvantages of using a Clone machine is the components that go inside the Clone PC. Generally, local brand/ PC cloners buy accessories from whoever offers the lowest price. Unlike foreign brands, the components used in local machines sometimes are not properly tested. So quality remains uninsured.


