ILO is a United Nations Specialized Agency. The International Program on the Elimination of Child Labour (IPEC) is one of its technical cooperation programs. It was launched with the aim to work towards the prevention and elimination of child labour worldwide. Since its inception in 1992, the ILO/IPEC has made efforts collaboratively with its member states, constituents and other national stakeholders in combating the child labour problem through policy and action on various fronts. IPEC became operational in Bangladesh when the Government of Bangladesh signed the MOU on a National IPEC Program with the ILO in 1994. Since then over 75 Action Programs have been Implemented by the Government, NGOs and trade unions. Thousands of child workers were reached through various means. Adoption of the ILO Convention No 182 in 1999, led to prioritizing IPEC's actions towards the elimination of the worst forms of child labour. In this context, ILO/IPEC recently launched an action-oriented project titled "Preventing & eliminating worst forms of child labour in the urban, informal sector," for which seeks applications from candidates for a team comprised of 3 Coordinators (as described below), to assist the Chief Technical Adviser (CTA-responsible for the implementation of this project), under the overall supervision of the Director.

1. COORDINATOR on Monitoring, Verification & Tracking (MVT) Description of duties:

Under the technical guidance and administrative supervision of the CTA, the Coordinator is responsible for the implementation of the MVT component of the project: assist in base line survey(s); provide necessary training for monitors, design and maintain a MVT-system (data base), monitor the project activities on a regular basis and prepare progress reports. This component involves a combination of strategies: identification of child workers, family, employers and the prevention through a continuous workplace and community monitoring system. Qualifications:

- Bangladesh national (women are especially encouraged to apply); University degree in economics, management, social science or
- equivalent. At least 5 years project management and implementation
- experience
- At least 3 years MVT-methodologies, training and design/use of data base experience/specialization.

2. COORDINATOR on Social Protection (SP)

Description of duties:

Under the technical guidance and administrative supervision of the CTA, the Coordinator is responsible for the implementation of the SPcomponent of the project: withdrawal of children, NFE, mainstreaming, vocational skill training, viable alternatives for families and employers, referral services, health care etc; provide necessary training and assist implementing partners in program design, delivery and reporting; monitor the project activities on a regular basis and prepare progress reports. Qualifications:

- Bangladesh national (Women are especially encouraged to apply). University degree in economics, management, social science or equivalent.
- At least 5 years of project management and implementation experience
- At least 3 years of work experience/specialization in education vocational training and/or micro financing.

Competencies:

Proven capacity to initiate and backstop programs and activities with ILO constituents, NGOs and others; good social analytical skills (including gender sensitivity & analysis); good written and verbal communication skills in English and Bengali; organized systematic work style; demonstrated ability to work independently with minimum supervision; ability to work in a team and good interpersonal skills/relations; proficient in basic computer software (MS Word, MS PowerPoint, MS Excel. etc); ability to train and guide people; ability to work under time pressure and meet deadlines.

3. COORDINATOR on Advocacy & Awareness raising (AA) Description of duties:

Under the technical guidance and administrative supervision of the CTA, the Coordinator is responsible for the implementation of the AAcomponent of the project, to be implemented mainly by the ILO/IPEC; action identification and initiatives at all levels and target groups (incl. (ex-) child workers, in close consultation with the other coordinator of the project; creation of a wide and diverse range of partners and alliances; monitor the project activities on a regular basis and prepare progress

- Bangladesh national (Women are especially encouraged to apply). University degree in social science (e.g. mass communication) or
- At least 3 years of development work, social work, child work, and
- Didactical and/or journalistic experience and familiarity with ILO policies will be added advantage


