British retailer Marks and Spencer announced Thursday plans to slash around 4,400 jobs and shut down loss-making overseas stores under a shake-up aimed at turning around its struggling business.

Marks and Spencer (M and S) is to close all of its 38 stores in Continental Europe, with the loss of 3,350 jobs.

France will bear the brunt of the job losses, with the closure of 18 stores. The retailer said it would also

Officials sources said, the income of RAKUB was Tk 119.90 crore in the 1999-2000 financial year while the expenditure was Tk 117.76 crore, resulting in a net

The audited accounts of the RAKUB was approved by the Board of Directors at its 203" board meeting held here Tuesday.

The bank incurred loss for the seven consecutive years from the 1991-92 to 1998-99 financial years. The amount of loss was Tk 61.73 crore in the 1998-99 financial year, sources said.

RAKUB authorities have undertaken a five-year 'Reforms Programme' in the 1999-2000 financial year with a view to turning the bank into a profitable bank and achieved a successful result in the first year. Provision against the classified loan worth Tk 34.78 crore has also been reduced in the first year.
