The Zimbabwe Cricket Union /(U) is perhaps one of the most well-run organisations in a country where the political and economic landscape appears to be in a state of disorder.

With the economy presently facing multiple problems, only cricket in this beautiful African nation promises to flourish under the charismatic leadership of Heath Streak. Indeed, the 28-yearold paceman gave his nation the feeling that they were capable of upsetting the best by taking Zimbabwe to new heights during the 1999 World Cup in England.

The soft-spoken six-foot giant from Bulawayo also enjoyed an inspiring tour of India with a newlook side.

Now he embarks on a hectic international schedule on home soil starting with a one-day and Test series against Bangladesh.

Although the series against Bangladesh would be more like a warm-up ahead of the next fixture against India, the Zimbabwean captain made a very pertinent observations about the opponents and also of his own team while talking to a group of Bangladeshi journalists on Friday.

Admitting that this would be the first time Zimbabwe would start as favourites, Streak however

"We are certainly favourite to hard work for us and for a change it will be nice to play at home.
