No train under pvt management, JS told

Communications Minister Anwar Hussain said yesterday said that Bangladesh Railway has not given any train to private management for its operation.
"But the private sector had been integrated with the commercial service of 50 trains on different routes of Bangladesh Railway," he said while replying to a question from M Fazlul Azim of BNP from

Noakhali in the Jatiya Sangsad.
Replying to another question from M Mostafizur Rahman (Fizu) of Awami League from Dinajpur, the communications minister said Bangladesh Railway has a total of 60,613.997 acres of land. "Of this, 655.35 acres in the Eastern Zone and 1,325.39 acres in the Western Zone are under illegal occupation," he informed the questioner.
To another question raised by Ramesh Chandra Sen of Awami League from Thakurgaon, Anwar Hussain said the government has no plans to launch an inter-city train service between Dhaka and Panchagarh.

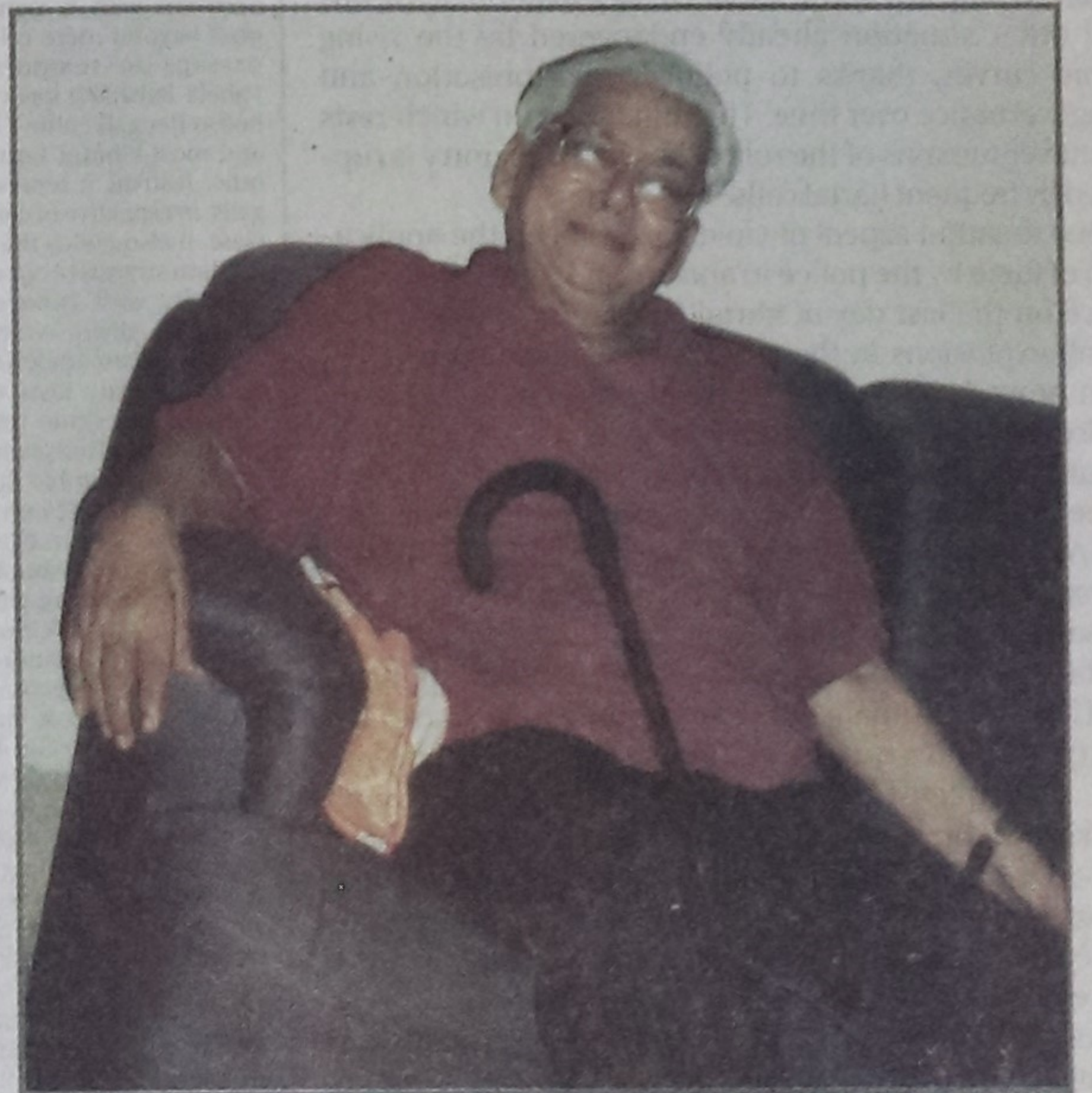
Globally reputed scholars, physicians and academics of medical science from home and abroad will gather here for a two-day Second International Meeting on Tropical Medicine Update beginning today.
