

Work on Eco parks in Moulvibazar inaugurated amidst protests

Tribal people won't be evicted: Minister

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Moulvibazar

Forest and Environment Minister Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury on Sunday laid the foundation stones of two Eco parks at Muraichhara and Madhabkunda under Moulvibazar district amidst protests by tribal people.

They will continue living inside the project areas, she said, adding that the government will distribute documents of land among the tribal families but this land will be non-transferable.

Later, the minister addressed two separate public meetings organised on the occasion. Sultan Md Monsur Ahmed MP, Md Shahabuddin MP, Dewan Farid Gaji MP and Md Nuruzzaman, Chief Conservator of Forest, accompanied the minister.

A total of 1,500 acres of land will be utilised for the parks including 667 acres in Madhabkunda and 833 acres in Muraichhara forest lands.
