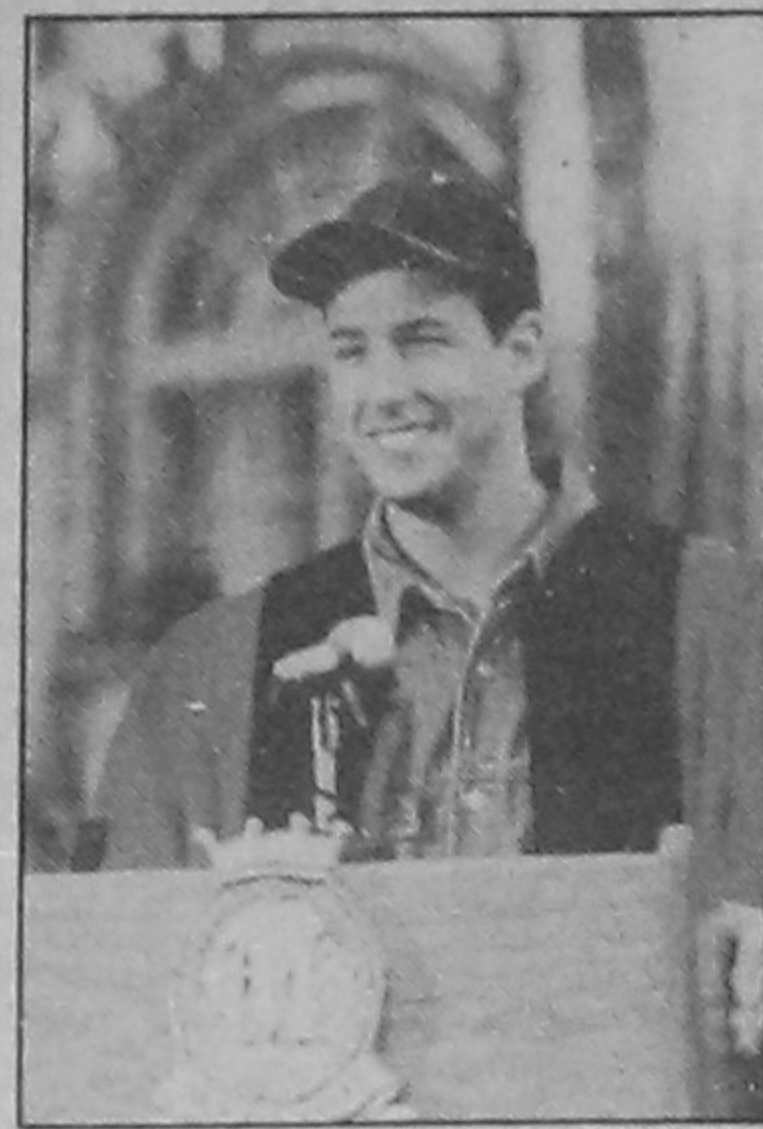

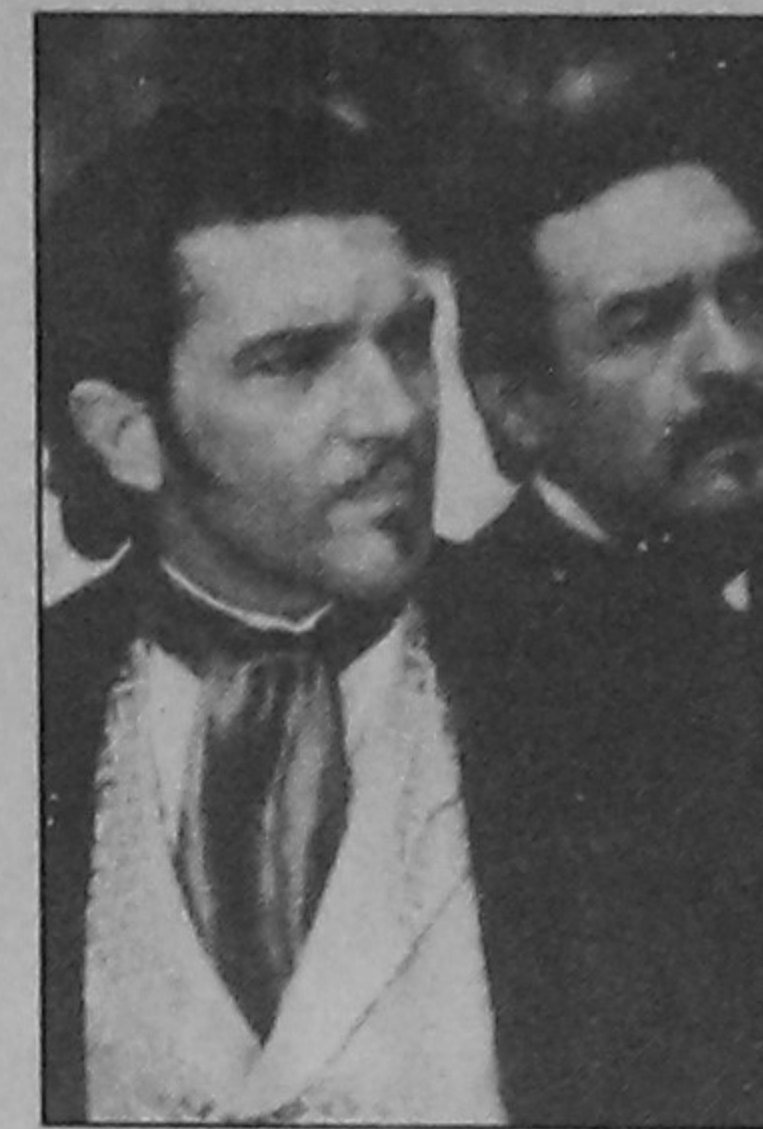
The Movie

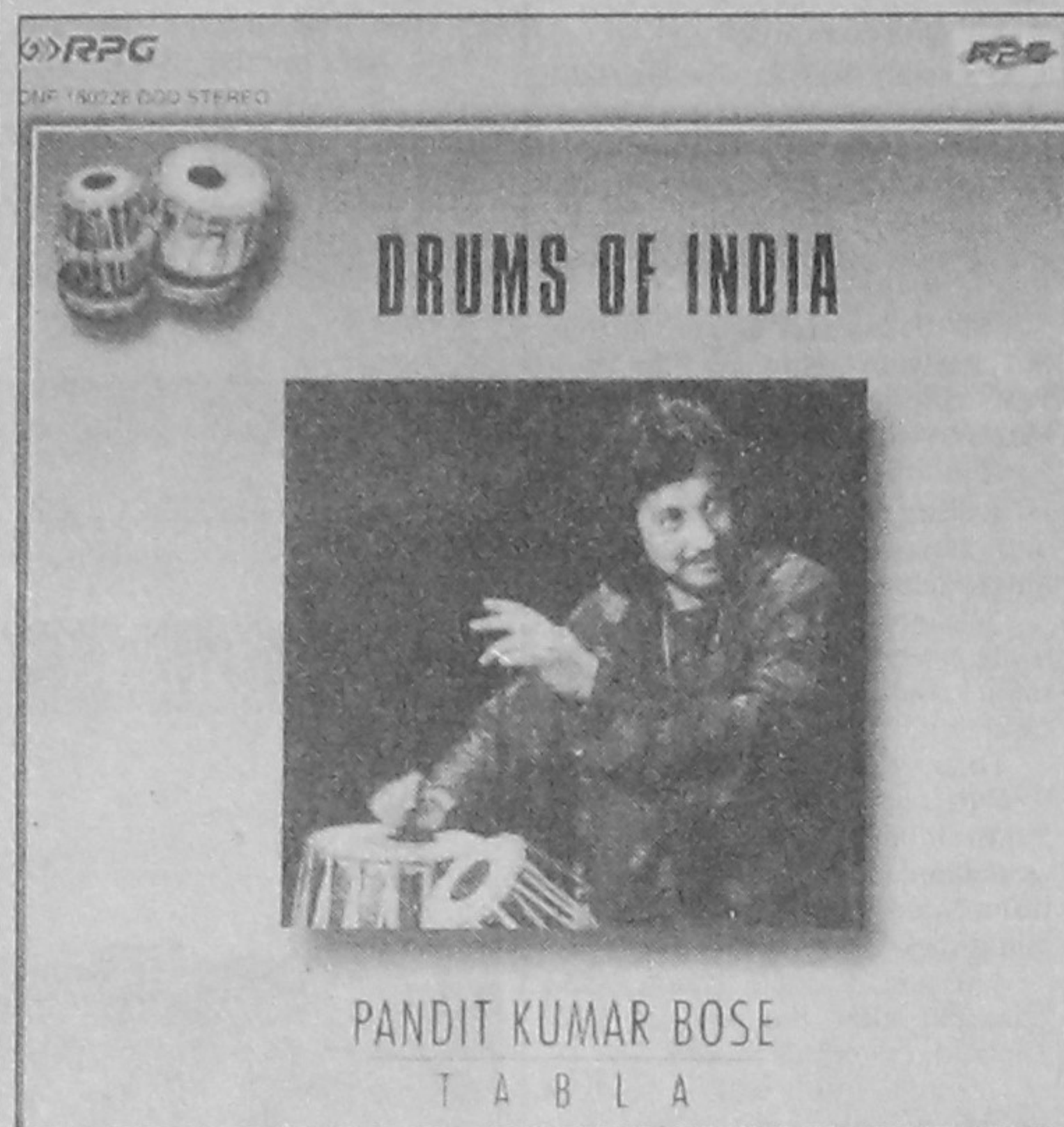

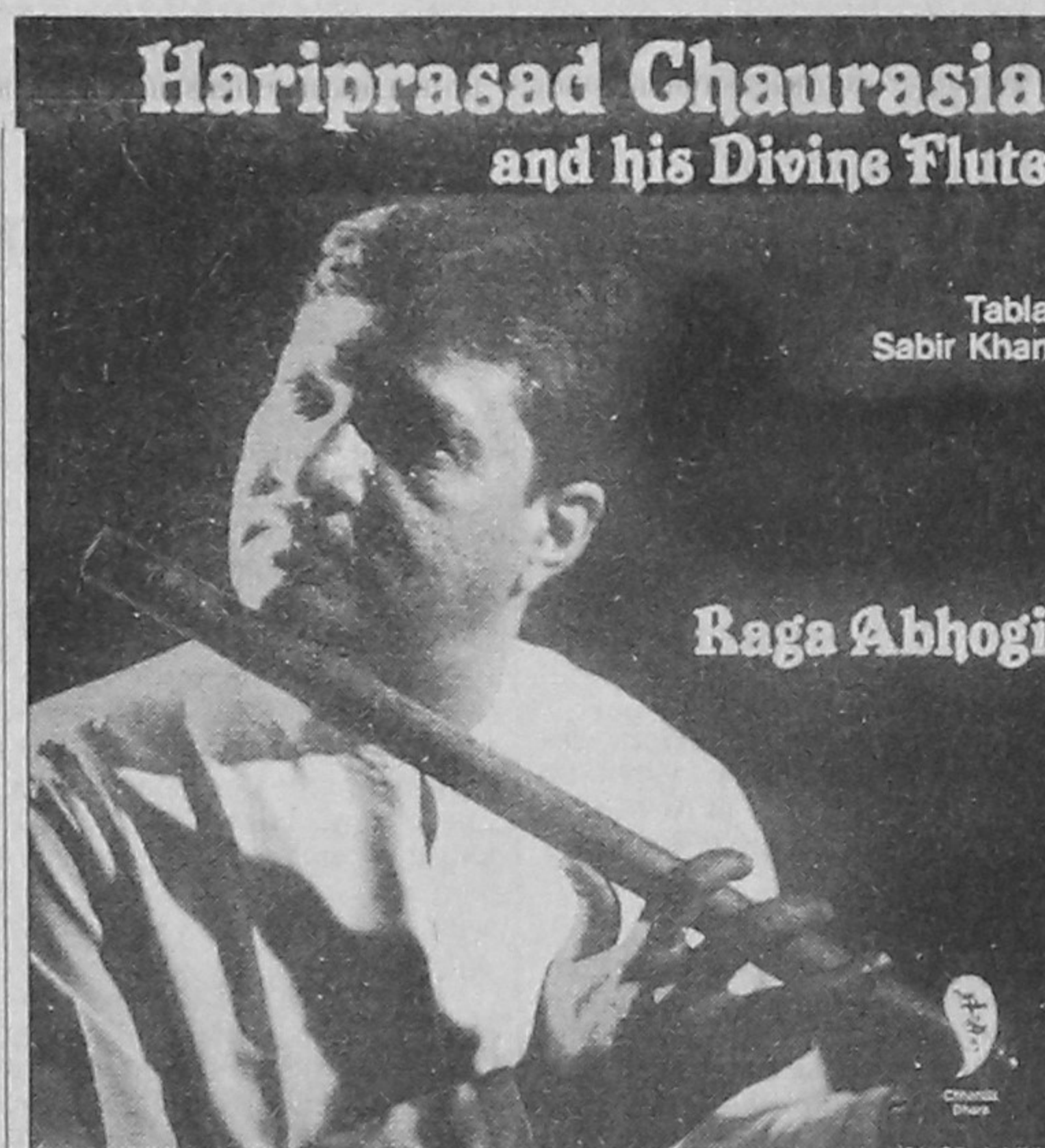

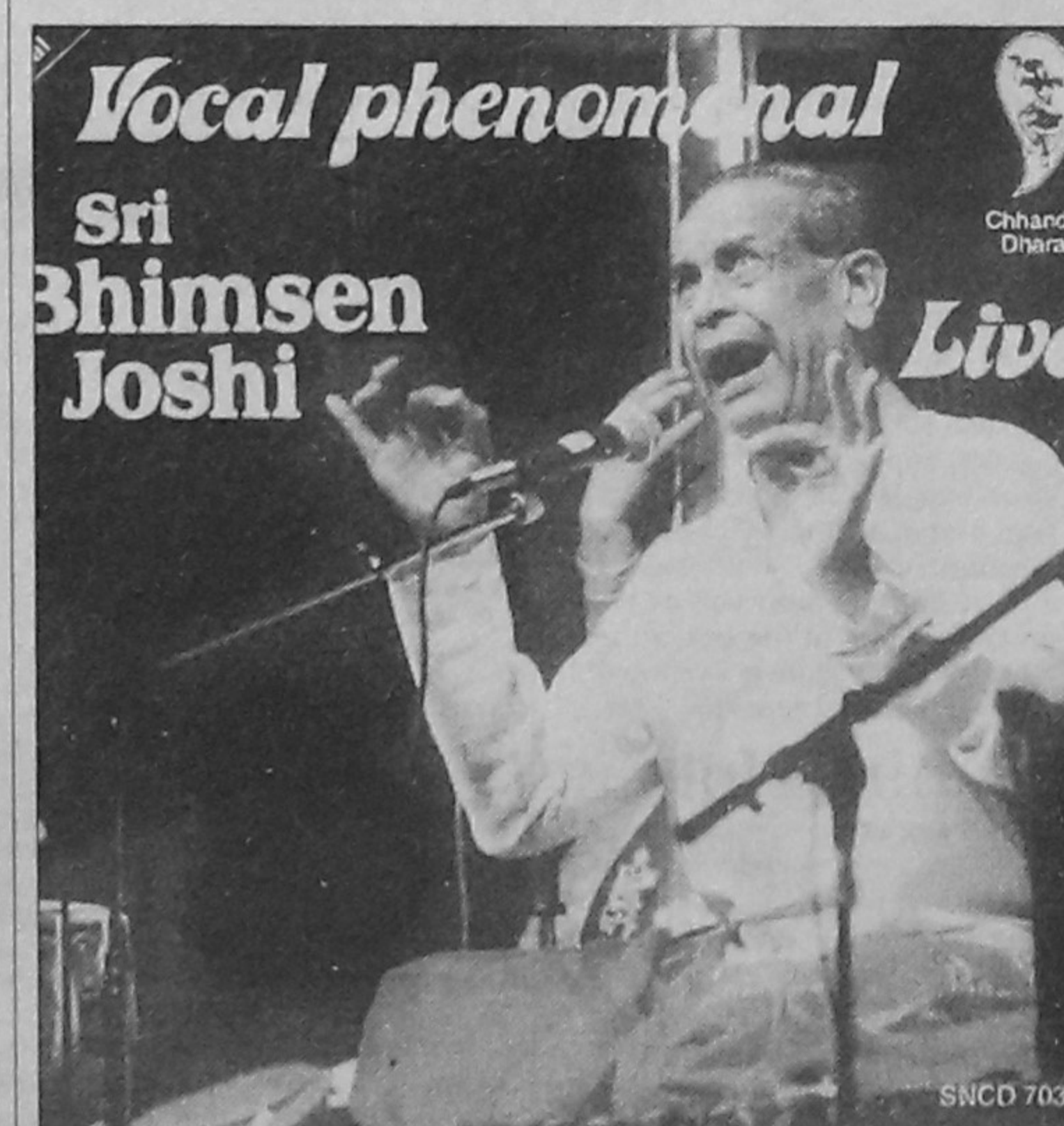
Drums of India

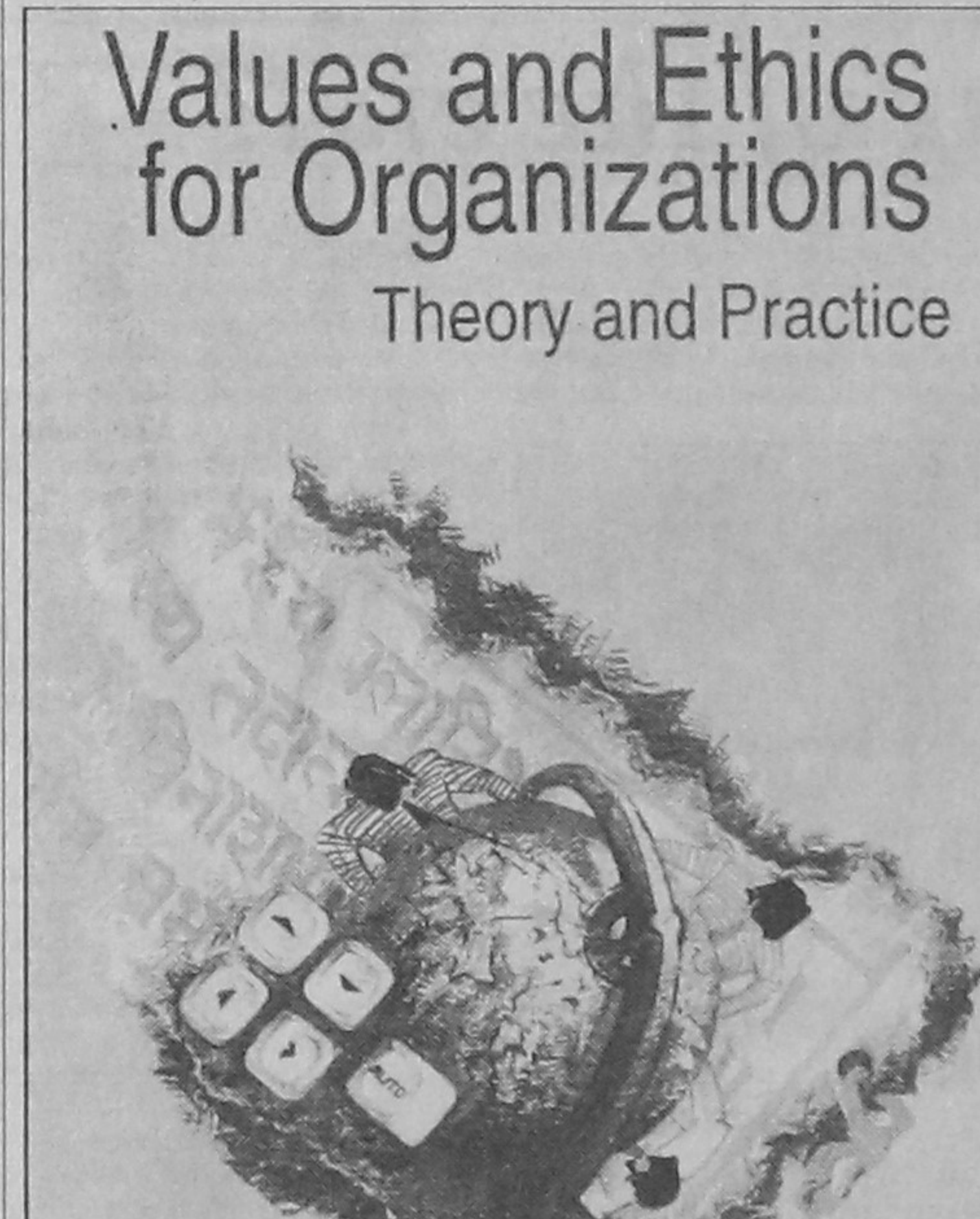

One of the earliest and certainly among the most brilliant actresses of nineteenth-century public theatre in Bengal, Binodini Dasi (1863-1941) was also a powerful writer with a voice of her own. Her autobiographical writings Amar Katha (1912) and Amar Abhinetri Jiban (1924-25) along with her poems speak of a woman who wanted much more than contemporary society was willing to grant her.



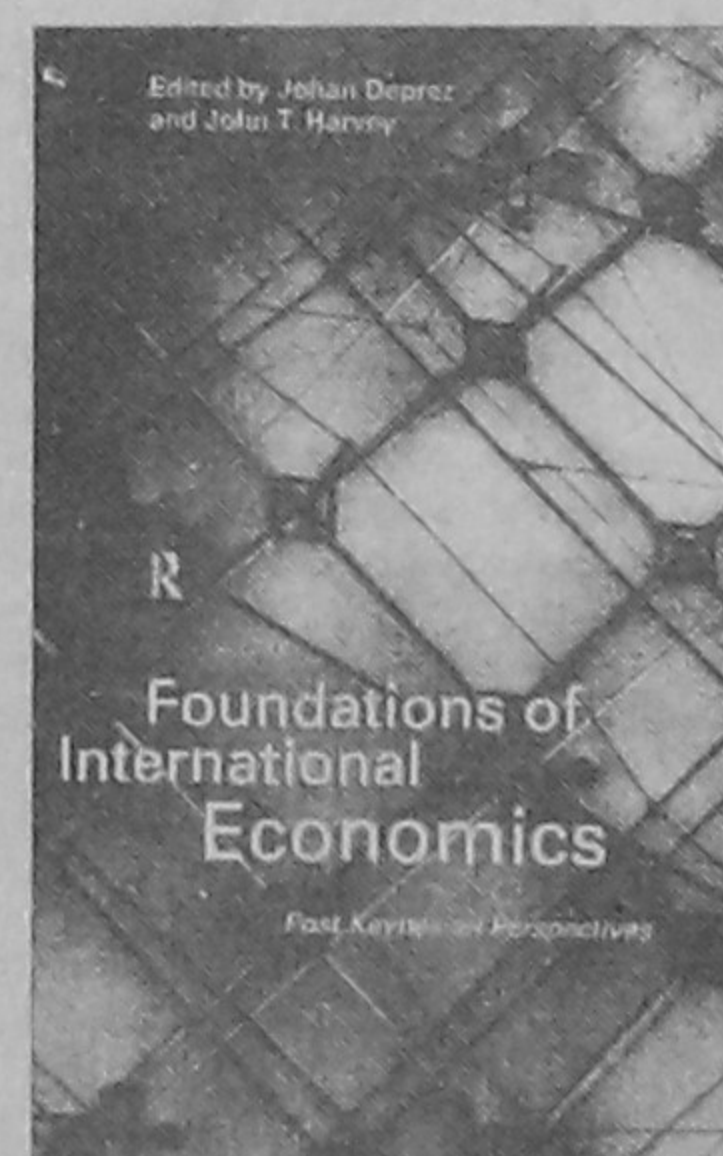
Values and Ethics for Organizations

This edited collection presents a Post Keynesian perspective on international economic theory and analysis, running the gamut from finance to trade and development.

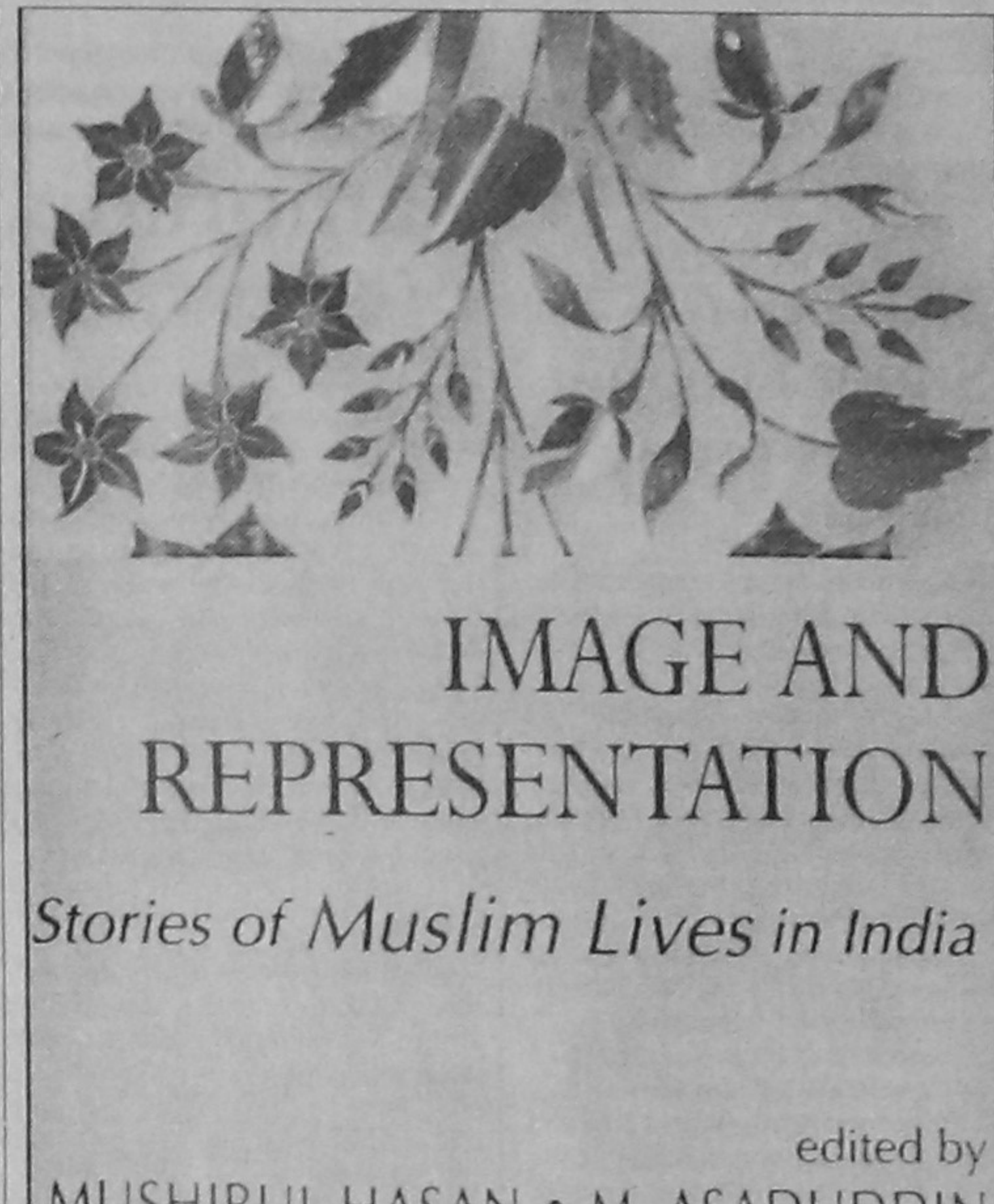
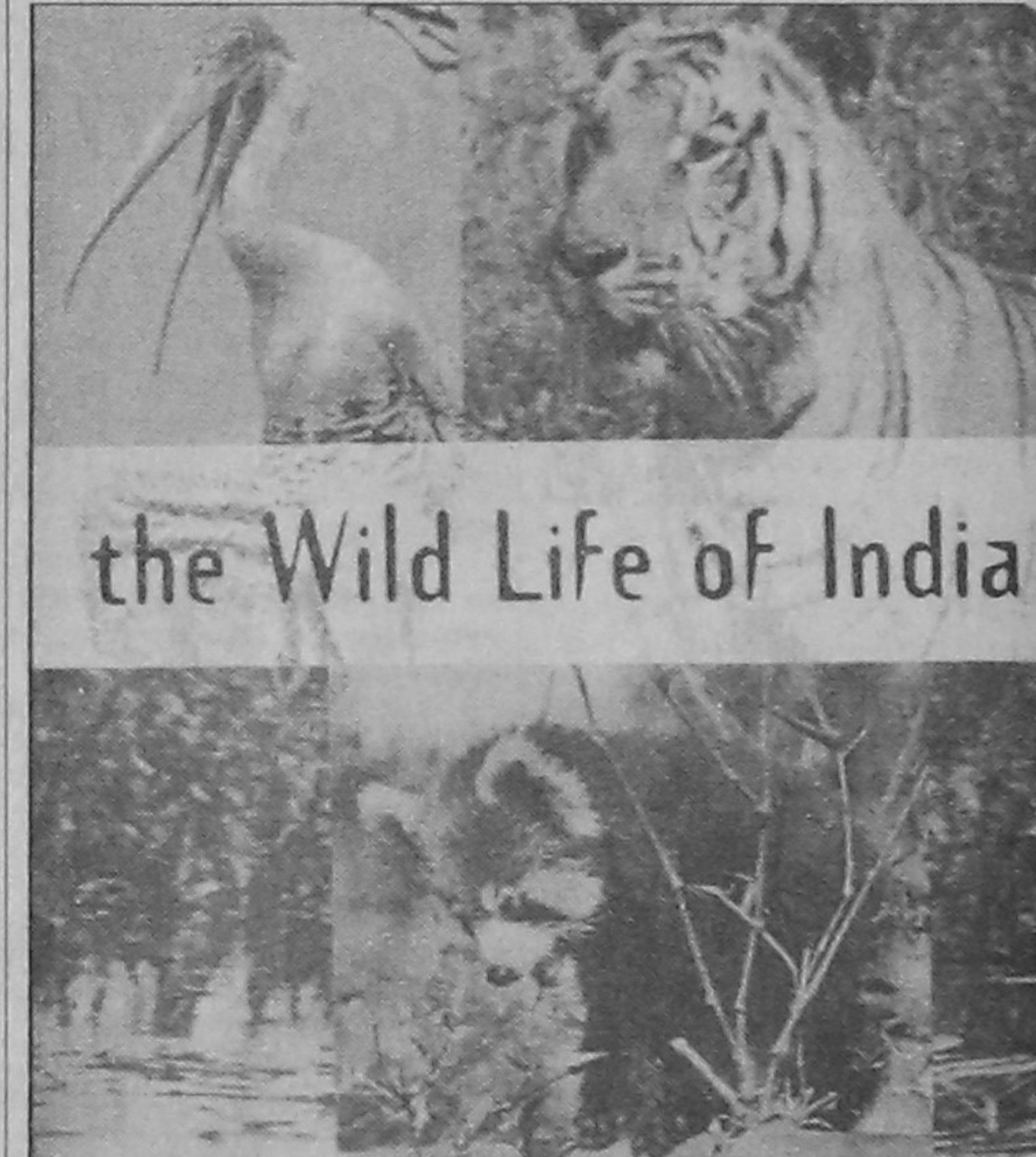


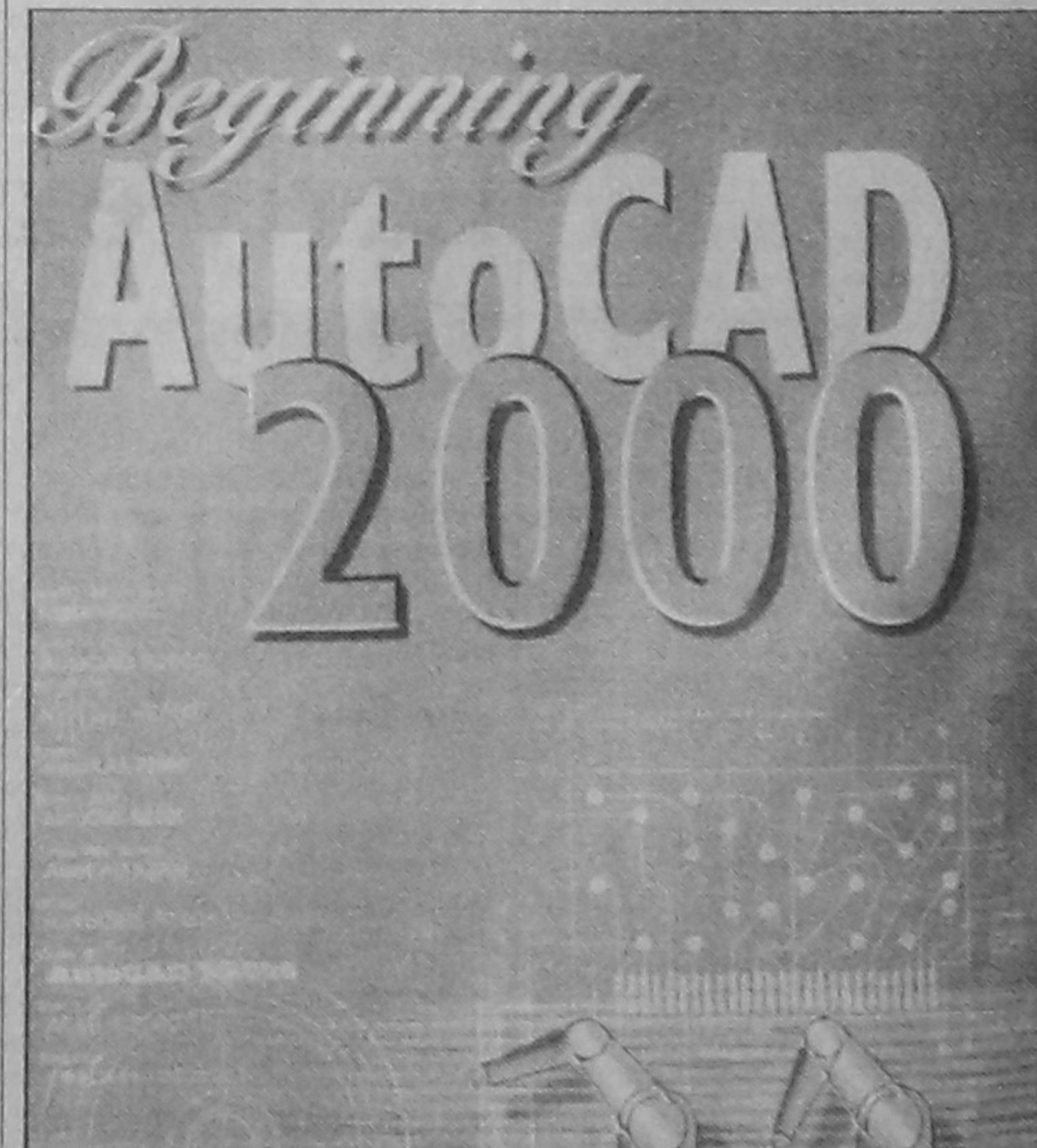
Image and Representation
