Use high-speed gateways to boost software export

Experts tell seminar

Leading engineers and educationists urged the IT professionals of the country yesterday to use existing digital data networks (DDN) in Dhaka, Khulna, Sylhet and Bogra along with high-speed gateways to boost software exports.

Pointing to several loopholes including lack of optimum bandwidth, absence of fibre-optic backbone and indirect access to information superhighway, they said our bright students and young professionals are equipped with good command over English and they have an analytical mind, talents, vision and willingness to break the barriers.

They were speaking at a seminar titled "Development of young engineers and educated youths as international standard IT professionals" in the conference hall of IT training centre ExecuTrain at Dhamondi.

Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh (IEB) task force for development of IT professionals in association with ExecuTrain of Bangladesh and "Bangladesh-2000" organised the seminar.

Chairman of Bangladesh-2000 Engineer M Shahjahan Khadem delivered the keynote speech. Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof A K Azad Chowdhury, Housing and Public Works Secretary Engineer Quamrul Islam Siddique, Chief Engineer of PWD Eskender Hayet, and Engineer Hafizur Rahman of BITB addressed the seminar.

Prof Azad Chowdhury said people of the least developed countries like Bangladesh would

be marginalised further in the globalised economic order. He said the only silver lining is the access to global knowledge.

By 2005, he said, our close-door neighbour India has set up strategic plans to earn 20 billion US dollars by exporting software and IT-enabled services.

The VC said our boys and girls who received graduation in various disciplines are better equipped as they possess good command over languages, sound analytical mind and 16 years of schooling.

He said in a knowledge-based society, all university students have rights to have at least one personal e-mail account and unlimited access to the Internet. But due to bandwidth problem, lack of necessary hardware and financial constraints, we have failed to meet their basic IT needs, he added.

Quamrul Islam Siddique said optimum development of the IT sector is never possible without proper telecommunication infrastructure.

He said that the concerned authorities should try to establish "Cyber-kiosks" in all "upazila headquarters. Primarily the government should take the lead while the private entrepreneurs would start their own IT-kiosks later.

Myanmar has already established links with global fibre-optic backbone of the information superhighway in Akiai region, he said, adding that more high-speed data gateways should be created by BITB in shortest possible time.

M Shahjahan Khadem said the government's efforts in this sector was not implemented properly and the five leading institutions - Dhaka University, BUET, Khulna University, Shahjalal University of Science and Technology, Sylhet, and Chittagong University - are yet to receive government funds for producing quality IT professionals.


