Asmat Ali Sikder dead

Advocate Asmat Ali Sikder, a prominent student leader of the sixties, freedom fighter and former parliamentarian died of heart ailment at his Monipurpara residence in the city on Sunday night. He was 61.

An ardent follower of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, Asmat Ali Sikder as a student leader played a key role in the anti-Ayub movement in the sixties.

The then martial law authorities cancelled his degree and expelled him along with Sheikh Fazlul Huq Moni from the Dhaka University.

Sikder was elected a Member of National Assembly in the 1970 general elections. He was also elected a Member of Parliament in 1973 elections from Barguna.

He left behind his wife, one son, two daughters and a host of relatives and admirers to mourn his death.

His qulhawani will be held on May 11 after Asr prayers at his residence at 12/3 Monipurpara.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday expressed profound shock at the death of Asmat Ali Sikder.

She visited the residence of Sikder to pay her last respect.

Environment and Forest Minister Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury, Food Minister Amir Hossain Amu, Deputy Minister for Food, Dhirendra Devnath Sambu, Dr H B Iqbal, MP and A S M Firoj, MP and Mahmuda Sawgat, MP accompanied the prime minister during the visit.

DIPPING LINE MANAGER (CHEMIST) :

The applicant must be graduate in Chemical Engineering/Post graduate in Chemistry/Applied Chemistry preferably with work/research experience in a major industrial concern (health care/chemical/other process industry) or research institutes but preferably in natural rubber latex process technology. Being the chief of dipping section, the incumbent will work as the main chemist and supervise the compounding, dispersion control, dipping line control and in-process quality control.

TESTING & PACKAGING MANAGER :
