## Journalists take to streets against repression

UNB, Dhaka

Reporters demonstrated in the city yesterday in protest against attacks on journalists by terrorists backed by the influential quarters patronised by police.

During a street demonstration they renewed their pledge that the reporters, despite the repression, would continue to write to expose the misdeeds and vandalism in society.

"If the terrorists go unpunished, they will not spare anybody," said Anwarul Haq, president of Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU) while addressing the rally.

He said if the terrorists and their patrons think that the tortured reporters would stop writing against their misdeeds, it would be a great mistake.

Earlier, the DRU brought out a procession from its Segunbagicha office that paraded city streets

chanting slogans for stopping the killing, torture and repression on journalists across the country.

Leaders of journalists community took part in the street demonstration for immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the repressors of journalists.

The rally was addressed, among others, by Ataus Samad, Akhtar Ahmed Khan, Altaf Mahmud, Shafiqur Rahman, Golam Tahabur, Zahid Newaz Jewel, Azmal Haq Helal and DRU general secretary Motaher Hossain Masum.
