

Call to protect rights of indigenous people

Leading anthropologists of Bangladesh and India yesterday said lives and cultures of over 4,000 ethnic minority groups across the world have been threatened due to unjust explosion of the so-called modern science and technology.

The whole civilisation and mankind would be threatened if due rights of the ethnic minorities were not realised, they observed at a two-day international seminar on "Indigenous Peoples of Bangladesh and Eastern India: Emerging Problems" being held at the BIAM auditorium in the city.

A local think tank, Research and Development Collective (RDC), in collaboration with the Anthropology Department of Kolkata University organised the seminar to share problems and prospects of the indigenous people of Bangladesh and India.

Vice-chancellor of Dhaka University Prof AK Azad Chowdhury inaugurated the seminar while Dr Ambedkar Chair Professor of Kol-

kata University Prof Buddhadeb Chaudhuri addressed the inaugural session as chief guest.

Environment and Forest Secretary Mahfuzul Islam and Chairperson of the Anthropology Department of Kolkata University Prof Ranjana Roy were present at the inaugural ceremony as special guests while General Secretary of RDC Mesbah Kamal spoke at the press release added.

The speakers said diversity is a must for smooth running of the globe, as nature is fond of diversity.

They said all human beings are similar to some extent but it is cultural pattern that differs them.

The definition of nationhood should be changed to accommodate culture and heritage of all the ethnic minorities, they added.

Most of the participants observed that the historic CHT peace accord has recognised the due demands of the tribal people of the region.

Some of them, however, said implementation of the accord should be expedited.

BTTB cautions against mobile phone fraud

Lawyers urged to protect rights of the oppressed

Eminent jurist Justice Nayemuddin Ahmed yesterday urged the lawyers to contribute more to protect the rights of the oppressed in society considering themselves as human rights activists.

Speaking as chief guest at a certificate awarding ceremony at Bangladesh Bar Council Bhaban, he expressed his concern over the growing reports of violation of human rights at the private level.

"Not only the government machinery is violating human rights, but also individuals are violating the rights of oppressed in the society," he said.

Legal Education and Training Institute (LETI) of Bar Council organised the function as part of the winding up of a week-long courses on human rights training programme (HRTP) and training of trainers (TOT).

Advocate MA Salam Talukder chaired the function, which was also addressed by Advocate Mahbubul Huq, Advocate Dilruba Afzabi and Advocate Rabiu Hasan Young.

Salam Talukder, who is the chairman of the human rights committee of Bar Council, called upon the lawyers to help strengthen their respective Human Rights Monitoring Cells to provide legal support to the victims of human rights violation.


