Regional cooperation needed to check human trafficking

BSS, Kathmandu

State Minister for Planning Dr. Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir yesterday stressed the need for strengthening cross-border cooperation in preventing trafficking in children and spread of communicable diseases.

"Cross-border cooperation in preventing child trafficking and communicable diseases needs to be explored and acted upon and transnational cohesion should be fostered among all organisations, institutions and activists working to give a new meaning to the lives of children," he said.

The minister was speaking at the UNICEF sponsored meeting on children, "A South Asian Imperative: Investing in Children" here. He is leading a six-member

Bangladesh delegation to the meeting which began on Tuesday.

Referring to the improvement of the status of women and children in Bangladesh, he said the country experienced significant improvement in most of the indicators that measure success in the lives of children as the country has been implementing an impressive range of programmes since 1991.

"Bangladesh has given high priority to the protection and development of children in line with its Fifth Five-Year Plan formulated with the objectives of reducing infant mortality rate, malnutrition, providing universal access to basic education, combating child trafficking, eliminating violence against children and rehabilitating the destitute.


