Experts at BUET seminar say Voltage instability affects electronic gadgets

BSS, Dhaka

The regular weekly meeting of the Rotary Club of Dhaka North West will be held today at 7.30 pm at the residence of Rtn PP A Hafiz Chowdhury, House No 66, Road No 7/A, Dhannondi. It will be followed by a fellowship dinner hosted by Rtn PP A Hafiz Chowdhury and Ann Shyamoli Nasreen Chowdhury. All the members of the club and their spouses have been requested to attend, says a press release.

They were discussing the ongoing low voltage situation in the metropolis at a seminar on "Load

management and low-voltage problem" jointly organised by the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering and Bangladesh chapter of IEEE at Council Barhul of BUET this morning.

Vice Chancellor of BUET Professor Dr Nooruddin Ahmed, PDB chairman Brigadier General M A Malek Mollah, DESA Chairman S M Shamsul Alam, Prof Shahidul Islam Khan, Prof Dr S M Lutful Kabir and Prof Rezwan Khan, among others, spoke on the occasion.

Professor Nooruddin Ahmed said efforts are underway to procure a two to three megawatt independent power plant for BUET as most of the electronic gadgets and resources of the university are encountering visible damage due to low-voltage and other power problems.

He said serious endeavours are needed in this sector as most of the small generators create severe noise pollution along with emitting toxic gases like carbon mono-

oxide or carbon di-oxide and the city has very few oxygen producing trees to balance the situation.

Prof Dr S M Lutful Kabir, a leading power system researcher of BUET, said in a bid to improve the low voltage level of the distribution system, the 132/33kv and 33/11kv transformers have been made to operate at their high tap settings. Unfortunately, he noted that, this arrangement has not been providing significant improvement on the voltage level during peak hours.

"It creates a new problem during light load situation," he said.

Quoting a recent observation of the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) centre of Dhaka Electric Supply Authority (DESA), he said that due to high tap settings the voltages at 33kv and 11kv level become as high as 39kv and 12.5kv respectively in some substations during small hours of the day like 3 am to 4 am when the load is minimum.
