BNWLA calls for amending birth registration law

BSS, Dhaka

Bangladesh National Women Lawyers' Association (BNWLA) yesterday called for amending the anachronistic birth registration law, saying the existing legislation failed to ensure or promote registration of child birth.

In a workshop, under its advocacy programme on the issue, the association leaders said despite the current campaigns, the birth of less than 10 per cent newborns was registered since the local registration authorities had no accountability and the birth records were made necessary for certain practical purposes.

The workshop, also attended by newsmen, NGO and donor representatives including UNICEF, alleged that in some cases the concerned municipal or city corporation officials or employees were making brisk business out of the process, taking it as a "commercial venture instead of official duty".

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
