BNWLA calls for amending birth registration law

BSS, Dhaka

Bangladesh National Women Lawyers' Association (BNWLA) yesterday called for amending the anachronistic birth registration law, saying the existing legislation failed to ensure or promote registration of childbirth.

In a workshop, under its advocacy programme on the issue, the association leaders said despite the current campaigns, the birth of less than 10 per cent newborns was registered since the local registration authorities had no accountability and the birth records were made necessary for certain practical purposes.

The workshop, also attended by newsmen, NGO and donor representatives including UNICEF, alleged that in some cases the concerned municipal or city corporation officials or employees were making brisk business out of the process, taking it as a "commercial venture instead of official duty".

The workshop suggested involvement of field level health workers in birth registration in coordination with Union

Parishads (councils) or other local government bodies, which are responsible for the recording.

It also called on primary schools to demand birth registration certificates of students during enrolment as birth records are needed for SSC examinations and also during joining a job.

Health workers who provide effective services at household levels for pregnant women or new born children may easily gather some more information required

The government launched a birth registration campaign with UNICEF assistance in 1996 to particularly promote child rights, checking child marriage, prostitution, smuggling and rehabilitating disabled children.

BNWLA's president Faizia Karim Firoz, Executive Director Salma Ali, Shirin Nahar and UNICEF representative Azizur Rahman, among others, spoke on the occasion.

International environmentalists to visit the Sundarbans

Two international environmental activists yesterday exchanged views with members of the Forum of Environmental Journalists, Bangladesh (FEJB) on the possible impact of exploring oil from a block adjacent to the Sundarbans, the world's biggest mangrove forest.

Craig Bennett of the UK-based environmental organisation Friends of the Earth and Paul de Clerck, representing the Earth Alarm of Netherlands shared their concerns with FEJB members at a meeting at its office in the city.

Bennett and Clerck said they will visit the Sundarbans to have a first hand experience of the site. They also agreed to share their experience with FEJB on their return from the Sundarbans.

Earlier, FEJB Chairman Quamrul Islam Choudhury briefed the visiting environmental activists about the organisation's efforts in building public awareness about the environmental hazards, especially those concerning the Sundarbans, which has been declared a World Heritage Site.

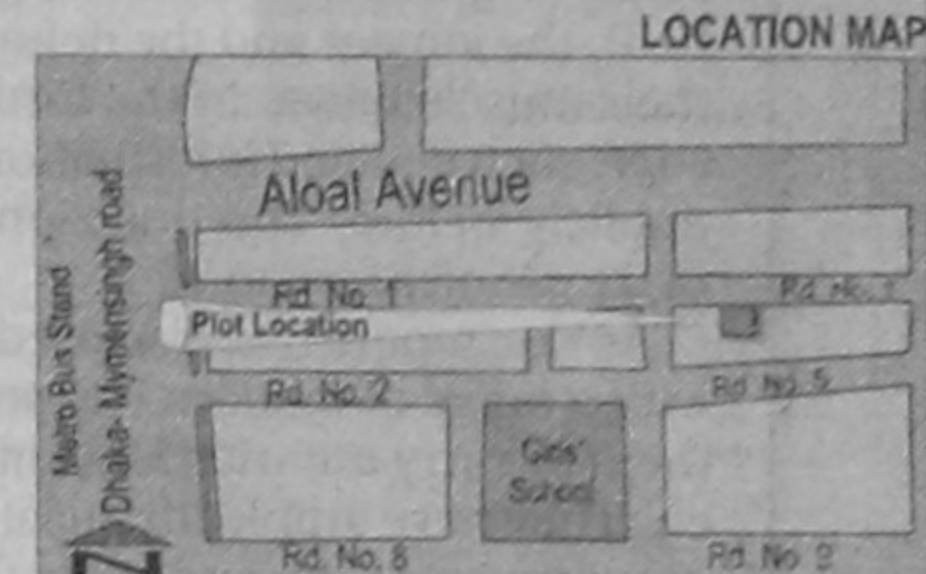

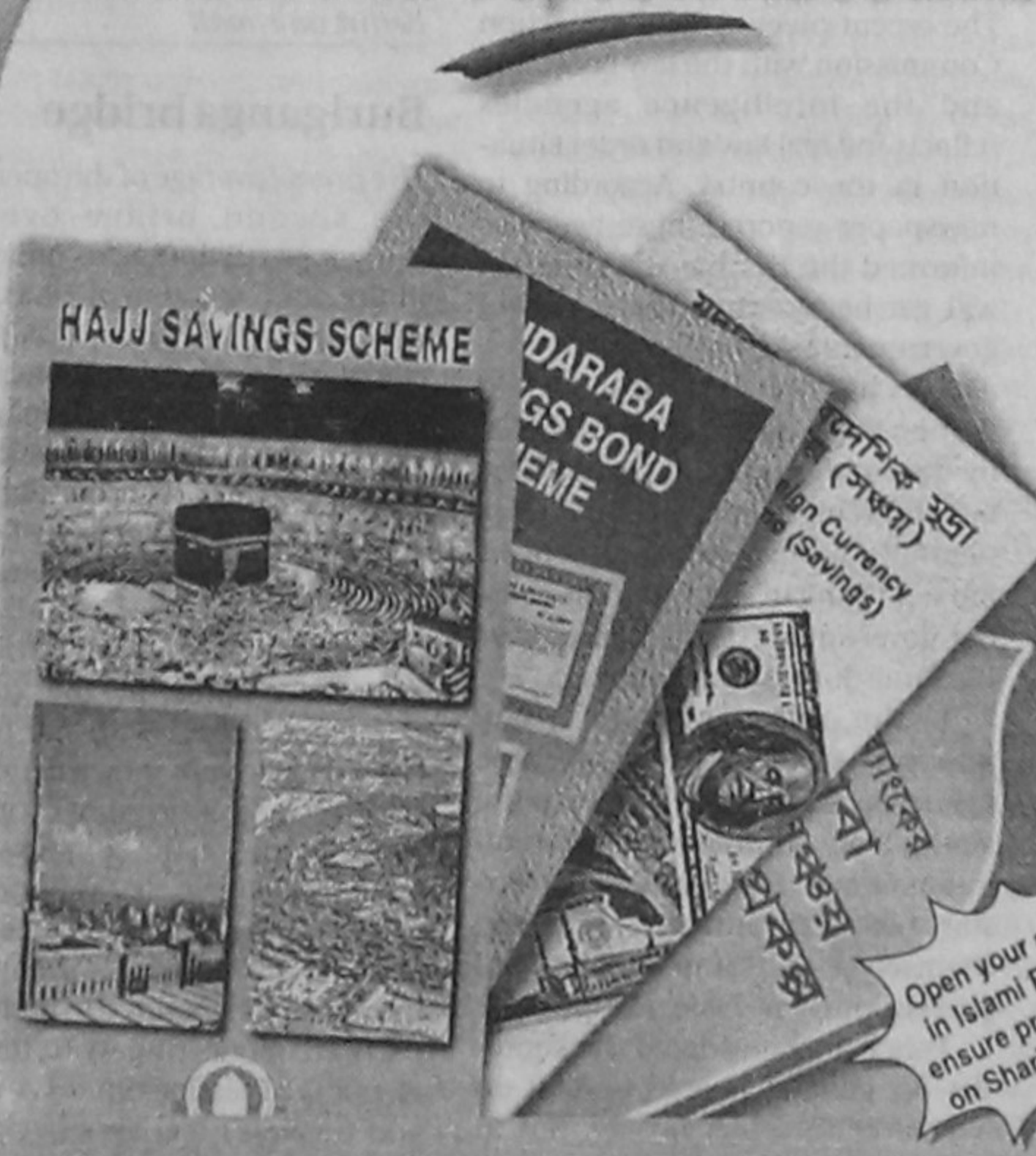
