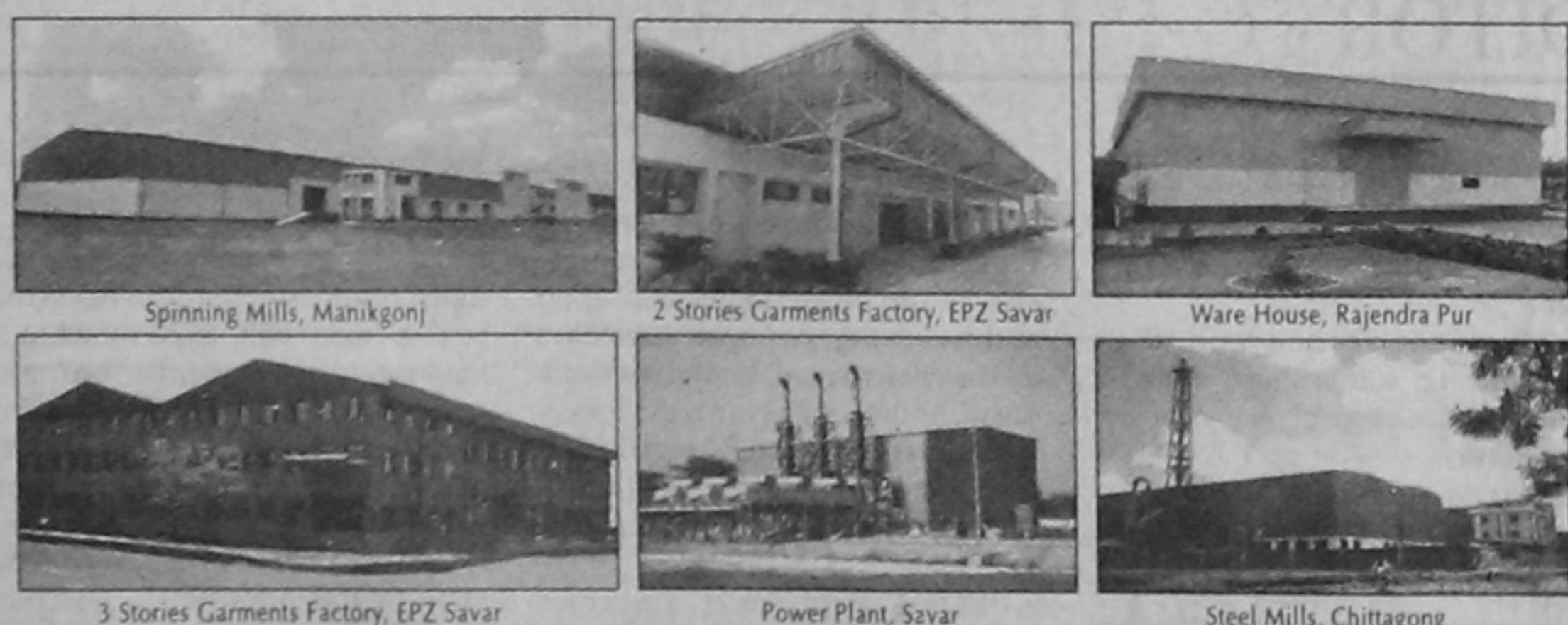

The fifth convocation of Independent University, Bangladesh (IUB) was held in the city yesterday. A total of 113 students, including 85 graduates and 28 MBAs, were conferred degrees at the ceremony.

The theme of the convocation was 'Higher Education for Advancement'.

Prof. Jamal Nazrul Islam, Director, Research Centre for Mathematical and Physical Science of the Chittagong University, delivered the convocation speech. Vice-Chancellor of IUB Dr. Bazul M Chowdhury and Treasurer A Hafiz Chowdhury were also present at the ceremony.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Jamal Nazrul Islam emphasised the need for acquiring knowledge and its application for economic and sustainable development and

In a rare event, the research paper of Khataman Ara Begum, the first Bangladeshi Muslim woman who obtained M.Ed Degree, is published after long 45 years in the form of a book yesterday.

Published by Institute of Education and Research (IED), the book titled 'The Language Development of Children' contained the study information on 46 children in the 50s.

Khataman Ara, also the First Class Bachelor of Teaching in the then undivided Bengal, submitted her paper in 1956 for the Masters of Teaching (M.T) degree.

Dr. Kamrunnessa Begam, IED Director, presided over the publication ceremony held at the Foundation for Research on Educational Planning and Development (FREDP).

Among others, Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor Prof A K Azad Chowdhury, National Prof Mohammad Shamsul Haq, Prof of Institute of Modern Language Monsur Musa and Prof Mohammad Ferdous Khan spoke at the function. Octogenarian writer Khataman Ara Begum was also present.

Work on project to supply arsenic-free water begins

UNB, Dhaka

Work on 20-sub-projects to supply arsenic-free water through alternative means instead of tubewells has begun in five upazilas of the country.

The work began with the signing of an agreement between Bangladesh Arsenic Mitigation Water Supply Project (BAMWSP) and 32 rural organisations and UP chairmen in Bheramara upazila in Kushtia on Thursday.

The signing ceremony was preceded by a workshop on implementation of the sub-project.

Presided over by the Nirbahi officer of the upazila, the function was attended by Project Director of BAMWSP and senior officials of Local Government Ministry and Public Health Engineering Department.

The activities of the project will be expanded in other affected upazilas after completion of the survey in five upazilas - Bheramara, Hajiganj, Gopalganj, Ujjirpur and Ishwardi.

The projects, on the basis of information of the survey and according to the demands of the local people, would under take digging and excavation of draw-wells and establishment of sand filters on the banks of ponds to supply arsenic-free water.

The project would cost Tk 83 lakh of which the BAMWSP would provide 80 per cent and the rural organisations give remaining 20 per cent in the forms of labour, local inputs and other works.

solving the world's genuine concerns.

The greatest challenge facing us is how to pursue economic and sustainable development for all the people without destroying the natural environment, he said.

He observed that poor quality of science education in schools and colleges in the country is one of the obstacles to good scientific research.

Because of various problems in state-run educational systems in the country, private universities and colleges have a role to play in education and at the same time further steps needed to make the co-operation between state and private education sectors more effective and meaningful, he said.

IUB VC Dr. Bazul M Chowdhury said that higher education in the developing countries is under strain while the developed countries are constantly raising the stakes in education.

He said, "Solution of the problem may be found by ensuring provisions for mixed funding, effective utilisation of physical and human capital of new technologies, updating of education curricula and improvements of governance".

Termining the convocation as the beginning of the next phase of every graduate's life, he said, "Now it's your turn to apply your creativity and knowledge for the development of the country which needs a highly qualified generation for its future."

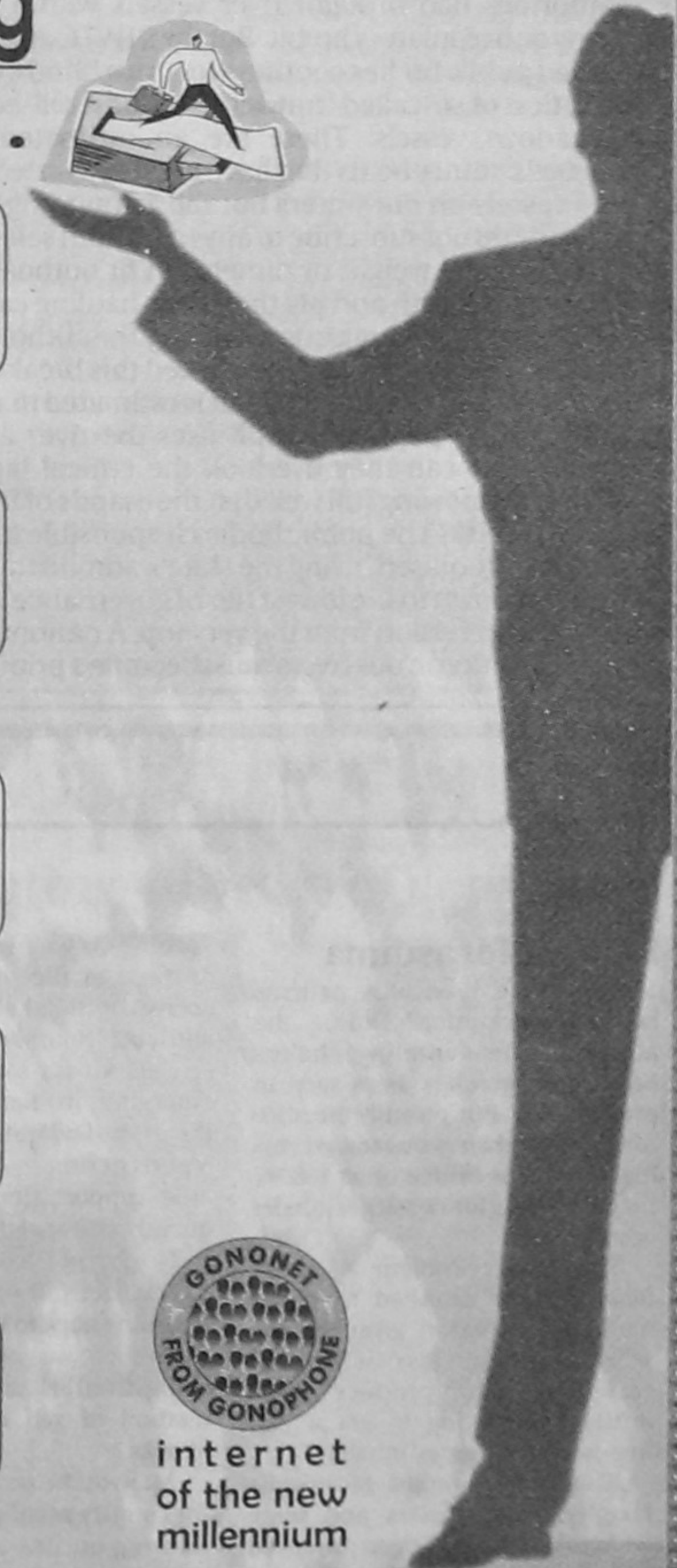
